Introduction

Seth Shri Roopchand Bhansali family, well known for it's charity, donated Rs 61 lakhs for the establishment of this college which is named for the patriarch and the matriarch of the family. Initially the college started functioning in Seth Mukanchand Balia school with 139 student's in the year 1995-96.

The chairman, Municipal Corporation, Shri Gyan Chand Pareek, allotted 41.39 bigha land free of cost to the college. later on 15 bigha additional Land was allotted by the District Collector. In addition to the Rs 61 lakhs donated by the Bhansali family, then M.P. Shri Guman Mal Lodha made available Rs 13.71 lakhs from his Local Area Development fund. The state Government made a contribution of Rs 58.61 lakhs through the District Rural Development Agency. The foundation stone was laid on 2nd August 1995 and the building was inaugurated on 3rd Oct. 1997 by then Higher Education Minister Government of Rajasthan, Shri Lalit Kishore Chaturvedi.

In the year 2003-04 the college was granted permanent affiliation by the M.D.S. University ,Ajmer and in April,2006 was registered by the U.G.C. for grant of assistance.

The college has set high standards academically since it's inception. It has consistently given many good results. In the field of sports too, the college has done well. It's handball team won the inter collegiate handball tournament in 2006-07. Three students Geeta, Rajan Bohra and Pinki Jain were selected to represent the University. In 2007-08, Geeta for handball, Jyoti Jodha for basketball and Kanta Rajpurohit for Kho-Kho were selected for University teams.

Literary and Cultural activities also find pride of place in the college. Regular programmers/competitions are held for song, dance, essay writing debates, poster/chart making ,rangoli, mehndi, making greeting cards and extension lectures. Seminars on development and burning issues are regularly organized.

Two units of N.S.S. are functional in the college. They hold various one day and seven days camps and inculcate a feeling of service to the society in the students. One unit of Rangers is also active.

On 18-06-07 Dr. Kiran Soni Gupta Commissioner ,Jodhpur inaugurated an Art's Gallery in the college. In this gallery are displayed various painting of the students of the Drawing & Painting Department.

The college has a well equiped (Computer and internet) Yuva Vikas Kendra and career counseling cell. The students are exposed to different career options and guided on how to go about preparing for competitive examinations interviews and development of personality.

For continual development of the curricular and co-curricular activities of the college, there is a registered body called Sanstha Vikas Samiti. This Samiti is charged with planning and executing various developmental scheme's, upgrading of the infrastructure and overall development.

From the Academic year 2012-13 the affiliation of the college has changed from M.D.S. University, Ajmer to J.N.V. University, Jodhpur. Now we are part of the J.N.V.U. family and hope to reach new academic standards under this more compact University.
