- Established with the motto “Tamsa Ma Jyotirgamaya”, the college is committed to plan and work for the academic excellence and holistic education to enlighten and encourage the young learners from semi-urban and rural backgrounds to unleash their creative potential to create a better future for themselves and society at large. Despite the huge drop out rate, the pass-percentage of the students has been 98% during the academic session 2021-2022.
- The college is the only government college for girls in the district which facilitates access of the girls from distant rural areas to higher education by providing them accommodation facility in the girls hostel situated in the college premises.
- The deep concern and commitment of the college towards academic excellence for the Optimum number of students can be observed in the way, the principal of the college has worked on the student-friendly decision to provide text books to the maximum number of students. As majority of the students are not able to get text-books due to financial constraints, so the college purchased 5581 Text-books with financial assistance from PD account. Although the college is facing dearth of human resources as far as college library is concerned, yet all the faculty members under the guidance of in-charges of the departments, Accounts officer of the college and the library committee did a commendable job in the whole process of procuring the 5581 text-books for the college -library.
- Adding to the pursuit of excellence, two faculty members from the department of Hindi got their books published during the session 2021-2022: -

- During the session 2021-2022, the college players earned a distinctive place for the college with their outstanding performance and participation in National and state level Sports Events: \_
- In All India Inter-University Events, three players in Power-lifting, two players in each respectively Power-lifting, Base -ball and soft-ball and one in gymnastics participated and performed well.
  - In West-Zone, Inter-University, six players of the college in Handball, and one player in each game respectively Kabaddi and Basket Ball participated.
  - The college won MGS University Championships for Inter-college Weight-Lifting, Power-lifting and Handball and Table-Tennis.
