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## Principal Office, Govt. Bangur College Didwana

### : Annual Report 2017-18 :

Heartly welcome and greetings to all of you at the annual function and prize distribution ceremony of the college. In this annual report, it is our humble effort to present the reflection of the activities of the college and the major achievements achieved in various fields. The foundation stone of Government Bangur College, a well-known educational institution of Didwana town, was laid in the year 1951 by the well-known Bangur Industrial House. It was started from intermediate level and was upgraded to graduate level in the year 1958 and as a postgraduate college in the year 1981. The Didwana city, well-known as historical Abhanagari, is holding the epithet of Upakashi because of being a pioneer in the field of education and culture.

At present, a total of 21 classes of undergraduate and postgraduate level are being run in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce. The total number of students studying is 4457. There are 3735 student are enrolled in the faculty of arts, 823 in the faculty of science and 499 in the faculty of commerce. One post of Principal, one post of Vice-Principal and 59 posts of faculty members are sanctioned in the college, of which 21 faculty members are working here and 23 posts of non-academic are approved in which 07 non-academic personnel are currently employed, due to the high number of vacant posts. Many problems are being faced. Repeated requests have been made to fill the vacant posts.

#### • Hostel:-

##### (a) Girl's Hostel -

By UGC fund, a girl's hostel building has been constructed in the college, which has accommodation for 40 girl students. The best accommodation facilities will be available for the girl students of rural areas. A committee has been constituted for running the girl's hostel.

##### (b) Boys Hostel -

The boys hostel has been constructed in the college which has a residential capacity of 55 students. Seats are reserved for SC and ST students as per rules. There is arrangement for volleyball, cricket and basketball in the hostel. The hostel superintendent residence is also in the hostel premises. There are 15 students registered in the session 2017-18. The committee coordinator of the hostel is Mr. Chainaram Mundalia and the hostel superintendent is Lt. Vijay Pal Meena.

#### • Rashtriya Uchaar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA)

Under the National Higher Education Campaign of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, a grant of Rs. 2.00 crore was approved to the college, out of which there is a provision for the college to receive the aid amount in the three installments. The first and second installments of the allocated budget were received Rs 50 lakh and Rs 1 crore respectively. In the current session 2017-18, the second installment amount of Rs 1 crore is allocated in the college.

According to the action plan of BOG and PMU committees and on the basis of recommendation, the following works were done-

1. Rs 70 Lakh for New Construction; construction of new stairs near Geography Department, seminar hall in west part behind college building and construction of two toilet blocks in hostel campus is in progress. Toilet construction work has been started.
2. Allocation of Rs 28 lakhs was done for Renovation work, which includes completion of incomplete construction works of Room number 133 and 134 and repair work of Room No. 3 is to be done. The repair work of Room number 133-134 have been started.
3. DLL Internet facility: Rs 2 lakh has been allocated for DLL connection and cross connection and Rs.159300/- deposited to the concerned department, the work will start as soon as possible Department of Telecom has received 50 lakhs earlier in the first installment and was spent on diesel generator, book work, automation of library, purchase of equipment etc. In this session, the audit team constituted by the Commissionerate got the works of RUSA audited on 26-07-2017. Dr. Jehangeer Rahman Qureishi is discharging the responsibility of RUSA in- charge efficiently.

• UGC Grant -

Mr. Chenaram Mudalia is the in- charge of this committee. The work of UGC is done under his direction. This college is recognized under the University Grants Commission under section 2 (f) and 12 (b). The college did not receive any grant amount from the University Grants Commission for the session 2017-18.

• College Development Committee :-

Registration No. 79 / Nagaur / 2002-03 of the College Development Committee was done on 10.09.2002 from the Registrar's Office, Nagaur, in which the final amount as on March 31, 2017 was Rs.4320196/- and from 01.04.2017 to 01.02.2018, Income and expenditure details are as follows - Income :- Rs.3571665/- from Examination Fee (Degree Development Fee), Narayan Das Bangur Smriti Hindi debate and Expenditure:-Rs. 2651246/- on Salary payment to contract workers, exam forms honorarium expenses, and other examination events as directed, and expenses on electricity, water, telephone bills etc.

• College Website -

The college has its own website under the leadership of Dr. Atul Garg, which is updated from time to time. Information about the courses being taught in the college, details of updated faculty members, information related to the departments and the entire activities of the college can be obtained on the website. • Online admission

Under the direction of PG Nodal Officer Dr. Arun Vyas and UG Nodal Officer Dr. Atul Garg, on-line admissions of undergraduate part I ( B.A, B.Sc, B.Com) and Post Graduate (Hindi, Geography, Sanskrit, Business Administration, ABST, Geology) were completed successfully. In BA Part I, a total of 1248 students got admission, in which 168 in Part I Mathematics, 160 in Bio and 134 students got admission in B.Com part I. Similarly, 40 students were admitted in Geography, 11 in Geology, 40 in Hindi, 37 in Sanskrit, 40 in Business Administration and 36 in ABST.

• Library / Reading Room:-

The library had made preparations to serve the readers from the very beginning of the session. Reader tickets were issued to the boys and the girls. 8720 books has been issued to the readers till date.

During the session, 146 books were purchased from the state government's non-plan budget of Rs.30,000/- and 96 books for SC and ST girls were purchased from the budget of Rs.15,000/-. During the year, the only permanent employee of the library, Mr. Babulal, Book lifter, was promoted to the post of Clerk in Government College, Jayal, and a contract employee was hired temporarily. Mr. Govardhan Lal Sharma, a retired librarian, has been working in temporary capacity.

• **Exam Result Analysis:-**

Like every year, the results of various classes of the college have been excellent in the university examinations which is a reflection of the healthy and prosperous academic environment of the college. The pass percentage of 05 classes has been 100 %, 04 classes have above 90 percent, 06 classes have 80 percent and 05 classes have above 60 percent. Thus the average examination result of the college is 85.80% which is a matter of pride for college.

• **Student Union Election 2017 - 18**

To acquaint the youth with democratic values and electoral system, Elections of student union are conducted every year on the basis of the recommendation of the Lyngdoh Committee. There is direct election for President, Vice President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary and Class Representative. The student union election was held on 24.08.2017. Election was conducted under the direction of Chief Electoral Officer Dr. Jehangeer Rehman Qureishi.

• **Seth Narayan Das Bangur Smriti Akhil Rajasthan Hindi Debate Competition** The prestigious literary activity "Seth Narayan Das Bangur Smriti Akhil Rajasthan Inter College Hindi Debate Competition 2017-18" of Government Bangur College, Didwana was organised with the financial support of Narayandas Bangur Charitable Trust, Kolkata. The event was completed on 20th December, 2017. In the competition, 42 participants from 24 colleges of the state kept their logical views in favor and against the competition topic. Dr. Jehangeer Rahman Qureieshi and convener were Dr. Gajadan Charan was the program coordinator.

• **National Cadet Corps-**

Three units of one company of National Cadets Corps are operated in the college. Lt. Vijay Pal Meena is actively conducting the activities of NCC, **The College NCC Cadet Senior Officer Mukesh Godara participated in the parade organized at Rajpath on 26 January 2017 in Delhi.**

• **National Service Scheme -**

Three units of National Service Scheme are running in the college. The officers of the three units are Mr. Habib Khan, Mr. Chainaram and Mr. Anil Kumar. Registration and renewal of students was done for three units. Under the orientation program, the volunteers were made aware of the importance, purpose & usefulness of the NSS.

The blood donation camp organized on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay at district headquarter and 10 students of this college went to Government College, Nagaur and donated blood.

From December 23 to December 29, 2017, a seven- day special camp was organized in which the volunteers of all the three units completed cleanliness competitions, poster display, tree pruning, plant protection and other creative works in the prescribed program under the direction of the officers in charge. The program has to be completed as per the prescribed schedule.

#### **Sports Activities -**

Mr. Anil Kumar is the in charge of the sports activities. Lokesh Acharya and Manmohan Singh, from the college, represented MDSU, Ajmer in the Inter- zone university competition after being selected for the inter- university tournament. Under the athletics (women) competition in the triple jump, the college's Draupadi Meghwal got third position in athletics (Girl) competition. Ranveer Singh, Sumesh Kumar and Rakesh Budia got third position in 4x400 relay race. Gopal got third position in triple jump competition Ranveer Singh got third position in 400 meters race.

In the junior category of Rajasthan State Cadet Junior Judo Championship, college student Sarita daughter of Mr. Bhomaram got second place and Rs.35000 prize money. In senior category student Manju Chaudhary, daughter of Mr. Suresh Chand and Meenakshi daughter of Mr. Suresh Chand got second place and earned prized money of Rs.51000 individually. Thus the college players brought laurels to the college by performing excellently.

#### **Youth Development Center -**

Youth Development Center is operated in the college with the vision of personality development and career building under the direction of Coordinator Mr. Chainaram, Mr. Vijaypal Meena and Mr. Naveen Kumar Das. In the current session, more than ten lectures, industrial unit visits, important days, cleanliness drive, plantation of saplings, blood donation awareness camp and Beti Bachao- Beti Padhao seminar etc. programs were organized under the Youth Development Center. The rest of the programs will be organized in the month of January as per the guidelines of the Industry Fair and Development Center of the Commissionerate.

#### **• Women's Cell -**

Dr. Manisha Godara is in- charge of the women's cell. This cell is working for women empowerment and all round development of girl students. For the active participation of girl students in the session 2017-18, selection were made among the girl students for the post of President, Treasurer and Secretary in the Executive Committee. Essay competition on "Culture, Language, Literature and History of Assam State" was organized under Women Cell on 22 November 2017. Sarita Kumari daughter of Mr. Chenaram got first place and Aruna Sharma daughter of Mr. Govind Prasad Sharma got second place in this essay competition. On 22 November 2017, a poster competition related to 'Assam State' was also organized.

#### **• College Sanitation Committee-**

The coordinator of the cleanliness committee constituted by the college is Mr. Habib Khan. A cleaning program was organized in the college under the motto 'Swachhata Hi Sewa' on second October Every member of the college family provides contribution in cleanliness drive.

#### **• Cultural program Panihari -**

A two- day cultural program 'Panihari' was organized on 21 and 22 December 2017 under the direction of program coordinator Dr. Manisha Godara. The chief guests of the program organized on December 21, were former MLA from Makrana constituency Mr. Ruparam Muravatan, special guest Mr. Chetan Singh Dudi, President Mr. Hanuman Prasad Dogiwal, special guest Mr. Gopal Lal Jadu and Prof. RS Sahu.

The program was graciously conducted by Dr. Gajadan Charan. The girl students performed Panihari dance at the beginning and at the end of the program.

- **Literary Cell -**

Mr. Habib Khan is in charge of this cell. In the literary cell, students are guided in the field related to literary activities. This platform provides an effort to enhance the talent of the college students. For the debate competition, the students are selected on the basis of merit and represent in the competition to be held in the various colleges of the state. In this session, college student Ms. Sonu Solanki B.A. 2nd year and Shahrukh Pawar B. A. Second year were sent to Churu Balika Mahavidyalaya, Churu in which student Sonu Solanki secured second position. Sonu Solanki participated in the competition organized at Sujala College, Sujangarh and Seth Motilal College, Jhunjhunu.

- **Human Rights Club –**

Human rights club is operated in the college, in charge of which is Dr. Irsad Ali Khan. Universal Human Rights Day was celebrated in the college on December 10, 2017, under which essay, quiz, awareness rally, poster, speech, poetry competition were organized.

**Alumni Council Committee:-**

This college is rich in its glorious list of alumni. Its convener is Dr. Jehangeer Rehman Qureieshi. Students are adding glory to this college by doing excellent work in various fields. All the former students have a continuous and intense association with this college.

- **Rover Ranger Scout Guide :-**

In the college there are three crews operated in the Rajasthan State Bharat Scout Guide having maximum strength of 24 students in each crew. 24 students each are registered in first year, second year and third year. The total number of maximum students registered in the rover crew of the college is 72. Ranger team among girl students is not operated due to lack of female ranger leader.

- **Publication of annual magazine -**

To promote the creativity of the students in the college, the annual college magazine Maruvibha is published. This magazine is an account of the years' activities of the college. This magazine will be published at the end of the session by the editorial board under the direction of Chief Editor Dr. Gajadan Charan.

- **Indira Gandhi National Open University Delhi and Vardhman Mahaveer Open University Kota Committee :-** Study Center of Indira Gandhi National Open University, Delhi is established in the college, its in- charge is Dr. Irsad Ali Khan. This center is under the Commissionerate, College Education Rajasthan, Jaipur. The specialty of the IGNOU examination is that the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and girl students have the facility to fill forms free of cost.

**Student Employment Counseling, Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell :-**

Under the guidance of Dr. Gajadan Charan, the convenor of this cell, on 30.01.2018, an employment fair was organized under the Employment and Entrepreneurship Cell in the college for the benefit of students, under which District Sainik Welfare Officer, Didwana Life Insurance Corporation officials, Panchayat Samiti, Department of Information and Technology, Punjab National Bank and Municipal officials discussed in detail about the various opportunities of employment among the students. Employment and Entrepreneurship counseling and selection desks were set up and the students gave interviews.

## Scholarship Committee :-

For the convenience of the students, the commissionerate has prepared scholarship portals. The nodal officer of this portal in the college is Mr. Habib Khan. All the scholarship recipients this session have applied online.

### (A) Chief Minister Higher Education Scholarship Scheme: -

The Chief Minister's Higher Education Scholarship Scheme is being operated from the session 2012-13 with the objective of providing scholarship for higher education to the cross-lingual students of all sections of the economically weaker sections of the society. In the session 2016-17, 375 students of Arts Faculty, 60 students from Commerce Faculty and 117 students from Science Faculty students have been benefited under the Chief Minister's Scholarship Scheme. In the session 2017-18, under the Chief Minister's Scholarship Scheme a total of 965 applications have been received.

(B) Devnarayan Girl Scooty Distribution Scheme: - Scooties were distributed to 03 girl students of this college in BRM Government College, Nagaur (Nodal College) under Devnarayan Chhatra Scooty Distribution Scheme in Devnarayan Chhatra Scooty and Incentive Scheme 2016-17.

For the session 2016-17, scholarship has been approved for 11 girl students under the Devnarayan Incentive Scheme. In session 2017-18, online applications of 09 girl students have been received under Devnarayan Scooty Scheme.


### (c) Meritorious girl student scooty distribution scheme: -

In the session 2016-17, 30 scooties were distributed to 30 girl students of the college at Government Madi Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Nagaur (nodal college). In the session 2017-18, applications of 66 girl students have been received under the meritorious student scooty distribution scheme.

### (d) Social Welfare Scholarship Scheme:-

Online application forms are being filled for Social Welfare Scholarship.
