: Annual Report 2018-19 :

Hearty welcome and greetings to all the faculty members, student union officials, intelligentsia and dear students in the annual function and prize distribution ceremony of the college. In this annual report, it is our humble effort to present an image of the activities of the college and mayor achievements achieved in various fields. The foundation of Didwana city's education hub Government Bangur college, was laid by the Bangur industrialists in the year 1951. Started as a center of higher education from intermediate level, this college was upgraded to graduate level in the year 1958 and as a postgraduate college in the year 1981. Well-known as historical Abhanagri, The Didwana city is holding the epithet of Upakashi because of being a pioneer in the field of education and culture.

At present, a total of 21 classes of undergraduate and postgraduate level are being run in this college in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce, The total number of students studying is 4403. There are 3127 students enrolled in the stream of arts, 830 students in the science stream and 446 students in the commerce stream. One post of Principle, one post of Vice- Principal, one post of Assistant Accounts Officer and 59 posts of faculty members are approved in the college, of which 27 faculty members are currently employed 22 non-academic posts are approved, of which 07 non-academic personnel are employed.

• Land-Building Structure:

The college has 33.5 bighas of land under its ownership, in which the college building, sports ground, hostel and the central library of the college are situated. Well-furnished and ventilated class rooms (5 rooms of size 30 × 40, 13 rooms of 20 × 25 and 3 rooms of 28 × 40) are available. Apart from this Geography, Physics, Geology, Zoology, Botany, Computer Science and English language laboratory rooms are available. There are separate arrangements of rooms for games, storage, examination control, student council, student counseling center, newly constructed seminar hall, 45 x 60 size auditorium, establishment office room, record room etc. along with Principal and Vice-principal office. In this year, the construction work of the grand main gate of the college was completed.

***Hostel :-**

1 Girls hostel: Courtesy of UGC in the college, the construction work of a girl's hostel has been completed, in which has an accommodation of 40 girl students. The best accommodation facilities will be provided to the girl students belonging to rural areas. A committee has been constituted for running the girl's hostel.

2 Boy's Hostel : The Boy' hostel located in the college premises is available for the regular students. It has a residential capacity of 55 students. In this, seats are reserved for SC/ST students as per rules. The hostel has also sports grounds for handball, volleyball, cricket and basketball games. The hostel superintendent's residence is also in the hostel premises. There are 10 students registered in the session 2018-19. The committee coordinator of the hostel is Mr. Chainaram Mudalia and the hostel in-charge is Mr. Prakash Garg.

• Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhivan (RUSA) -

Rashtriva Uchchar Shiksha Abhivan was started in colleges on the basis of 60:40 contributions under the joint aegis of Central Government and State Government. This college was selected for the RUSA scheme, under which a grant of Rs 2.00 crore was approved, out of which the college received the grant in three installments. The utilization certificate of Rs 02.00 crore was sent to the Commissionerate within the stipulated time. For the benefit of the students in the college, as per the guidelines received from RUSA Cell (Commissionerate, College Education Rajasthan, Jaipur) the RUSA budget was used as follows.

3:- Equipment Work:

- E. A new DG Set was purchased to ensure uninterrupted power supply to the college.

New works and repairs were done by the local PWD department and the remaining amount was used for various works. PWD has issued NIT for the use of the remaining amount and gave the assurance of starting the remaining work as per the instructions of the college. Approved project of RUSA work completed and the Commissionerate was informed. In order to utilize the full budget, partial changes in the approved DC were made point wise as directed by the BOG and the draft of the changed action plan was sent to the commissionerate for approval, which has been approved and received by the college on 20.02.2019. Dr. Jehangir Rahman Quereishi is holding the responsibility of RUSA in-charge efficiently.

• Library / Reading Room:-

The library is running to serve the readers from the very beginning of the session. Readers tickets were issued to the students. This year Rs. 25000/- was received from the non-plan budget of the state government. At present the total number of books is 68636. There are 20 newspapers, magazines, journals etc. in the library. More than 10,000 books have been issued to teachers and students in this session. Reference books in the reference room include encyclopedia, dictionary, year book, maps etc. and sufficient study material is available for the competitions. (List of Books have been computerized.), Mr. Govardhan Lal Sharma (Retired Librarian) is working in temporary capacity.

•College Website

The college has its website page link under the leadership of in-charge Mrs. Prem Parihar, which is updated from time to time. Updated information about the courses being taught in the college, details of faculty members, information related to departments and all activities of the college can be obtained from the website. •Online Admission (UG & PG) -

Online cells are being successfully operated in the college. It has successfully completed the online admission process for the session 2018-19 for undergraduate and post graduate classes. 2459 forms were filled for 1300 seats for graduation part first in arts. Similarly 638 students for 175 seats had applied for part first in Science Mathematics stream. 342 students applied for 175 seats in part first in Science Bio stream and 162 forms were received for 200 seats in part first in Commerce. The work of AISHE Portal has been successfully completed. In the Swachh Bharat mission also, the students enthusiastically applied and participated. Full details of the college web page have been updated on HTE Portal. In Undergraduate Part first (B.A. B.Sc. B.Com) and Post Graduate – Previous (Hindi. Geography. Sanskrit, Business Administration, ABST. Geology) online admission work was successfully completed. In BA. Part I, a total of 1300 students, in B.Sc. Part I, 175 students in Mathematics and 175 students in Bio and 146 students got admission in B.Com. Part I classes. Similarly, 40 students were admitted in Geography, 11 in Geology 11, 40 in Hindi, 28 in Sanskrit, 40 in Business Administration and 15 in ABST. Centre is operated as per the orders of the Commissionerate, College Education Rajasthan, Jaipur. About 350 students have taken admission in the college under the session 2016-17 and 2017-18 and the examination of TEE December 2018 will be conducted in the college from 01 December 2018 to 05 January 2019. Admission is being done online twice in June and December from the website of IGNOU and the examination form is available in March and September and being filled online. Field assignments are to be submitted every year in March and September. The specialty of this examination is that the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and girl students have the facility to fill the application form free of cost.

• **Vardhman Mahaveer Open University Kota Committee (VMOU)** - The study center of Vardhman Mahaveer Open University, Kota is established in the college, Dr. Irsad Ali is in charge of it. Under his guidance BAP BA, Bcom, BSc, MA, Mcom. MSc and Certificate Course, Diploma Course etc are being operated. Its application forms are filled twice in a session and examinations are conducted in the months of June and December.

• **Student Employment Counselling, Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell**:- The convener of this cell is Dr. Gajadan Charan. Free coaching classes have been started by the state government under the competitive efficiency program for the benefit of the students. The regular students of the college preparing for the various competitive exams like I.A.S. RAS Bank (Clerk & PO) Reet (1st & 2nd Grade), Police (Constable/SI) etc. are being benefitted. Under this scheme of the state government, the process of distribution of free competition books to all regular students is going on from January 26, 2019.

• **Scholarship Committee**:- For the convenience of the students, the commissionerate has prepared scholarship portals. Nodal of this portal in the college is Mr. Habbib Khan. In this session all the students eligible for the scholarship have applied online and receiving the same after scrutinizing their eligibility.


(A) Chief Minister Higher Education Scholarship Scheme: Chief Minister Higher Education Scholarship Scheme is being operated from the session 2012-13 with the objective of providing scholarship for higher education to the talented students of economically weaker sections of the society. Under Chief Minister Scholarship 741 students were benefitted in the session 2017-18. 813 students in the session 2018-19 were approved for Chief Minister's scholarship.

(B) Devnarayan Girls Scooty Distribution Scheme: - 03 girl students of this college have been selected in "Devnarayan Chhatra Scooty and Incentive Scheme 2018-19. Allotment is not done yet.

(C) Meritorious girl student scooty distribution scheme: Scooties were distributed to 18 girl students of the college in the session 2017-18. 24 girl students from the college were selected in the session 2018-19. Allotment is yet to be done.

(D) Social welfare scholarship programme : Online application forms are being filled for Social Welfare Scholarship.

(E) National Portal Scholarship Scheme:- In the session 2017-18, 18 students have been approved for scholarship. In the session 2018-19, 212 students have been approved and the work of scholarship approval is still going on.
