: Annual Report 2019-20 :

Hearty welcome and greetings to all the faculty members, student union officials, intelligentsia and dear students of the city in the annual function and prize distribution ceremony of the college. In this annual report, it is our humble effort to present before you an image of the activities of the college for the session 2019-20 and major achievements achieved in various fields. The foundation of Didwana city's famous education hub Government Bangur college was laid by the very virtuous and genuine Bangur industrialists in the year 1951. Started as a center of higher education from intermediate level, this college was upgraded to graduate level in the year 1958 and as a postgraduate college in the year 1981. Well-known as historical Abhanagri, this Didwana city is holding the epithet of Upakashi because of being a pioneer in the field of education and culture.

At present, a total of 21 classes of undergraduate and postgraduate level are being run in this college in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce, in which the total number of students studying is 4370, (3127 students in arts, 830 in science and 446 in commerce). There is one post of Principle, one post of Assistant Accounts Officer and 59 posts of faculty members are approved in the college, currently 28 faculty members are working here and 25 non-academic posts are approved, in which currently 08 non-academic personnel are working.

• Land-Building Structure :

The college has 33.5 bighas of land under its ownership, in which the college building, sports ground, hostel and the central library of the college are situated. Well-furnished and ventilated class rooms, 5 of size 30 × 40, 13 of 20 × 25 and 3 of 28 × 40 are available. Apart from this, Geography, Physics, Geology, Zoology, Botany, Computer Science and English language laboratory are available as laboratory rooms. There are separate arrangements for room, games room, storage room, examination control room, student council, student counseling center, principal and vice-chancellor office room, newly constructed seminar hall, 45 x 60 size auditorium, office room, record room etc. In the same year, the construction work of the grand main gate of the college was completed.

Hostel :-

1 Women hostel : Courtesy of UGC in the college, the construction work of a women's hostel has been completed, for accommodation of 40 girl students. The best accommodation facilities will be available for the girl students of rural areas. A committee has been constituted for running the women's hostel and the hostel premises have been leveled and cleaned.

2 College Hostel : The male hostel operated in the college premises is available for the study facility of regular students. It has a residential Capacity of 55 students. and seats are reserved for SC/ST students as per rules. The hostel has Playing Facility for handball, volleyball, cricket and basketball grounds. The hostel superintendent's residence is also in the hostel premises. There are 15 students registered in the session 2019-20. The committee coordinator of the hostel is Mr. Chaina Ram Mudalia and the hostel in-charge is Mr. Prakash Garg.

• Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) -

Rashtriva Uchchatar Shiksha Abhivan was started in colleges on the basis of 60:40 contribution under the joint aegis of Central Government and State Government. Respectively This college was also selected in the selection of colleges for the RUSA scheme, under which This college was also selected under RUSA Scheme among the colleges. A grant of 2. Crore was approved this Scheme. The utilization certificate of Rs 02.00 crore was sent to the SRD Commissioner ate within the stipulated time guidelines received from time to time by RUSA Cell Commissioner ate, College Education Rajasthan, Jaipur for the benefit of the students in the college. The RUSA budget was used as follows.

Project Work:-

New works and repairs were done by the local PWD department and the remaining amount was used for various works, to firmly determined letter was written to the PWD in this repeat. In response to which the PWD has imposed NIT for the use of the remaining amount and got the assurance of starting the work remaining and newly proposed works done as per the instructions of the college. As per the approved project of RUSA work, all the works were and the Commissionerate was informed In order to utilize the full budget, partial changes in the Approval DC were made point wise as directed by the BOG. The draft of the changed action plan was sent to the commissionerate for approval, which has been approved and received by the college on 20.02.2019. Presently the work of repairing the floor of the verandah in front of tennis court, verandah near room number 01 and 02 is being done. In the last inspection, the third inspection of the works done under the RUSA scheme was done (by the officers appointed by the Commissionerate on 03.10.2019) in which the complete report was sent to the Commissionerate and the inspection report of the said works was presented by Commissioner, RUSA Cell, Commissionerate Has been done. His report copy was received by the college on 17.02.2020. Dr. Jehangeer Rehman Quereishi is discharging the responsibility of RUSA in-charge efficiently.

•Seth Narayan Das Bangur Memorial All Rajasthan Hindi Debate Competition:-

The prestigious literary activity "Seth Narayan Das Bangur Smriti Akhil Rajasthan Inter College Hindj Debate Competition 2019-20" of Government Bangur College, Didwana was successfully organized on December 18, 2019, with the financial courtesy of Narayandas Bangur Charitable Trust, Kolkata. • **Library / Reading Room:-**

The library had made preparations to serve the readers from the very beginning of the session. 02 readers tickets were issued to the students. This year ₹25000/- was received from the non-plan budget of the state government. At present the total number of books is 69069. There are 20 newspapers, magazines, journals etc. in the library. Till date, 9,000 books have been issued to teachers and students in this session. Reference books in the reference room include encyclopedia, dictionary, year book, map and Sufficient study material is available for the competitions. (Books have been computerized.) Librarian, retired Mr. Govardhan Lal Sharma is working in temporary capacity.

•College Website

The college has its own website under the leadership of in-charge Mrs. Prem Parihar, which is updated from

•Online Admission (UG & PG) -

Online cells are being successfully operated by the coordinator Mrs. Prem Parihar in the college. SAIL has successfully completed

the online admission process for the session 2019-20 for undergraduate part one, post graduate part one. 1731 forms were filled for 1300 seats for graduation part first arts. Similarly 410 students for 176 seats had applied for Part Science Mathematics class. 224 students applied for 176 seats in Science Bio stream and 170 forms were received for 200 seats in Commerce. The work of AISHE Portal has been successfully completed. In this Swachh Bharat mission also, the students enthusiastically applied and participated. Full details of the college web page have been updated on HTE Portal. Under the direction of PG Nodal Officer Dr. Arun Vyas and UG Nodal Officer Dr. Abul Garg, in the session 2019-20, Undergraduate Part I (B.A. B.Sc. B.Com) and Post Graduate (Hindi, Geography, Sanskrit, Business Administration, ABST, Geology) online admission work was successfully completed. BA. In Part I, a total of 1280, students, B.Sc. 176 in Part I Mathematics and 146 in Bio and 131 students in b.com, got admission in Part I. Similarly, 40 nominations were made in Geography, Geology 11, Hindi 40 Sanskrit 14, Business Administration 40. ABST 16. Complete information is available on the college's portal hte.rajasthan.gov.in at number 198 of government colleges.

Certificate courses is being About 200 students have taken admission in the college under the session 2018-19 and 2019-20 and the examination of TEE December 2019 will be conducted in the college from 02 December 2019 to 03 January 2020. At college level BPP, BA, CIT, CNM, MA (PI.Sc.), M.A. (Gandhi & Peace) etc courses are on.

Every year admission is being done online twice in June and December from the website of IGNOU and the examination form is available in March and September and being filled online. Field assignments are to be submitted every year in March and September. The specialty of this examination is that the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and girl students have the facility to fill the application form free of cost.

•**Vardhman Mahaveer Open University Kota Committee (VMOU)** - The study center of Vardhman Mahaveer Open University, Kota is established in the college, Dr. Irsad Ali is in charge of it. Under his guidance BAP BA, Bcom, BSc, MA, Mcom. MSc and Certificate Course, Diploma Course etc are being operated. Its application forms are filled twice in a session and examinations are conducted in the months of June and December.

•**Student Employment Counselling, Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell**:- The convener of this cell is Dr. Gajadan Charan. Free coaching classes have been started by the state government under the competitive efficiency program for the benefits of the students. in which the regular students of the college Various competitive exams like I.A.S. RAS Bank (Clerk & PO) Reet (1st & 2nd Grade), Police (Constable/SI) etc. is being conducted. Under this scheme of the state government, the process of distribution of free competition books to all regular students is going on from August 15, 2019.

•**Scholarship Committee**:- For the convenience of the students, the commissionerate has prepared scholarship portals. Nodal of this portal in the college is Mr. Habbib Khan. In this session all the scholarship receiving students have applied online.
