ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Government Bangur college, Didwana is permanently affiliated to the M.D.S.U., Ajmer. The college is running under graduate and post graduate programmes: B.A., B. Sc., B. Com., M. A. in Hindi, Sanskrit, and Geography; M.Com. in Business Administration, A.B.S.T. and M.Sc. in Geology. Two departments Hindi and Geology were identified by the affiliating university for Ph. D. work. The institute is recognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi under (2f) and 12(B).

The college took several innovative initiatives for the quality assurance and effective implementation of curriculum, student support, skill development, academic enrichment and teaching-learning process. The college uses all the ICT facilities in day to day functioning. Well established computer centers are running in the college. The college has several programmes for skill development, quality enhancement and overall personality development under the aegis of NSS, NCC, YDC, CFE and Women Cell for the students. For quality teaching-learning process, the college is equipped with interactive smart board, broadband connectivity, Wi-Fi zones and INFLIBNET access.

Healthy Teacher - Students relationship and collective committed efforts of all members of this institute helped this college to be accredited as B + by NAAC in year 2006 and with CGPA of 2.68 on four point scale at B grade in year 2016 (In NAAC accreditation - Cycle: II). After NAAC accreditation (Twice in year 2006 and 2016), the college rapidly developed in many spheres of different sections. The infrastructural, ICT, library, teaching-learning facilities are enhanced satisfactorily. The college is at par with national standards in respect to the facilities for teaching with quality assurance for students. In spite of some vacant post, the college works as an integrated body for the welfare of the students and society at large. The college caters to the need of all the sections of the society.

2. Goal: Being very sensitive to the environment protection, the college works to maintain a green environment in the campus. Although there is no formal mechanism to conduct green audit of the campus, yet the college plans strategies to improve the existing conditions to make the campus eco-friendly. The college is committed for creating conducive eco-friendly environment through developing green and clean premises. College campus has a healthy, pollution free and eco-friendly environment. The institute has a green campus as regular plantation programmes are carried out. The institute aims to provide a polythene free green and pollution free environment to all the students studying in the college. The main goals of the institute are:

1. To maintain and improve the quality of the environment.
2. To create an awareness among students on environmental issues
3. To create an atmosphere where faculty members and students both contribute to the sustainable development of the college.

3. The context: The very concept of maintaining a green and eco-friendly environment requires a combined and consolidated effort at institute, faculty and student level. The biggest constraint is the non availability of the post of gardener, who if present, can make the scenario even more beautiful and enhancing. The plantation of all types of trees and plants some of which are native and some exotic are at present a source of achievement for the college.

4. The Practice: The institute has several green areas along with botanical garden. The college has many exotic plants. The knowledge of plants to under graduate students has a positive effect in their life.


