**RECOGNITION ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institutions had submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Teacher Education Courses.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by these institutions, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against letter of intent under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (earlier 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009), the Northern Regional Committee in its 233<sup>rd</sup> Meeting (Part -VI) held in 18, February, 2015 is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per-NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the following Institutions for conducting Teacher Education Course with an annual intake mentioned against their names from the academic session 2015-2016 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below :-

The Institution shall fulfil the revised Norms relating to infrastructure, instructional facilities, enhanced amount of Endowment and Reserve Fund, Number and qualifications of Teaching Staff, Curriculum and implementation strategies in view of the change in duration/intake of programme(s) offered in the institution within the time limit allowed by NCTE.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Government College, Plot No. 2553, 2256, Village-Uplafala, Post Office -Kherwara, District-Udaipur, Rajasthan had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition/permission for B.Ed. course on 10.12.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 233<sup>rd</sup> (Part-VI) meeting held on February 18, 2015 decided to grant recognition to the institution for B.Ed. course under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. Accordingly, the recognition order was issued to the institution vide order File No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-2845/233<sup>rd</sup> Meeting (Part-VI)/190175-187 dated 03.03.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its subsequent Emergent Meeting held on March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 resolved the case of the institution be placed before the NRC in its next meeting after the receipt of the Visiting Team Report. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was conducted under section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993 on 04.08.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the VTR was placed before the 241<sup>st</sup> meeting of NRC held on August 3-7, 2015 and the Committee decided that show cause notice under section 14/15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution U/s 17 on 14.08.2015 on the following point:-

- VT report reveals that size of multipurpose hall is only 1728 sq.ft. which is not as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its reply dt. 21.08.2015 and 31.08.2015 received in the NRC office on 25.08.2015 and 01.09.2015 in response to the aforesaid notice issued to the institution. The reply was considered by the NRC in its 242<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> to 03<sup>rd</sup> September, 2015 and the Committee decided as follows:-

- The reply of the institution to the Show Cause Notice was examined by the Committee. It is a fact that the institution is in the tribal area of Rajasthan where there is a perpetual shortage of teachers in the schools. There is always a demand from the local elected representatives to start the teachers' college as soon as possible. It is also observed that the Central Government is in favour of relaxing the infrastructural facilities in Government Colleges/DIETs which were constructed long ago. The Committee decided that in the interest of teacher education in the tribal belt, the recognition to the Institute which was kept in abeyance be restored on the basis of the reply of the institution given in response to the Show Cause Notice dated 19.08.2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Northern Regional Committee hereby restores the recognition granted to the Government College, Plot No. 2553, 2256, Village-Uplafala, Post Office-Kherwara, District-Udaipur, Rajasthan for B.Ed. course of two years duration for two units of 50 seats each.
