Two Best Institutional Practices 2018-19

1. Harvesting of the rain water:

With the ever-increasing infrastructure and rising of the demand for water supply, the Maharana Pratap Government College administration was forced to search for alternate means of getting uninterrupted water supply throughout the year. A high-level meeting chaired by the honourable Principal suggested harvesting of the rain water on an experimental basis. Two adjacent building blocks on both the flanks i.e., north and the south were selected for the proposed activity. The southern building block is in close proximity to a tube well, therefore the harvested rain water will ensure the re-charging of the ground water and the tube well will not go dry in the harsh summer months. After the completion/installation of the rain water harvesting mechanism, the college is now reaping the rich benefits obtained from the cost-effective investment.

2. Blanket ban on using the college premise for unauthorized advertisements:

The entire college premise including the extended one (i.e., the boundary wall) was once considered a-free-for-all advertisement billboard. The honourable Principal took the offenders to task, stern notices were served, and the offenders were made to remove their unauthorized advertisement hoardings, stickers, etc. For those advertisements which were painted on the boundary walls; the offenders were ordered to hide them with a fresh coat of yellow paint (the original colour of the boundary wall).
