The Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat Club was formed on 21.01.2022 in compliance with the Commissionerate order in this regard. The Objectives and Aims are based on developing unity, integrity and cultural exchange between various geographical and cultural sections of the country. The Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat Day is celebrated each month to review the activities of the previous month and introduce the students with EBSB activities for the current month. Activities are conducted to familiarize students on various aspects of National culture, State Culture and Local Culture. Special emphasis is laid on various concepts related to Language & Multi-lingualism which includes the International languages, National Language and local language. All these languages are discussed as a co-related medium of expression and sharing. Students are also made aware of Voter Rights and Voting Process to make them good and cultured citizens.

Along with this there are regular discussions on Environmental issues as it is the need of the hour. Students are also imparted knowledge of Historical Events so that they learn Indian history and world history. Along with this, Financial and Economic issues are discussed with them so that they understand the ups and downs of economy. Various other programs have also been introduced and various methods are used to ensure their participation. For this, many activities and competitions are held. For example, Quiz competition, Poem competition, Essay Competition, Republic Day Celebration and Martyrs' Day. The students are updated with knowledge on Gandhian thought of peace, love and unity. The concept of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava (AKAM) is shared with the students and they are given many opportunities for active participation. The Principal, EBSB committee members and other faculty members heartily contribute to the successful execution of all the activities. The students are highly benefitted by the activities and have committed themselves to the causes taken up. They have shared various folk songs and dances from Rajasthani, Asmese, Gujrati, Brij, Punjabi, Maharashtrian, Kashmiri and other cultures. They have pledged to spread the message forward and share it with society on different levels. The purpose of Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat is to unite the whole nation by sharing knowledge and cultural practices from different areas. This has created a feeling of universal brotherhood amongst the students.
