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A Word about the Topic

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The teachers' evaluation refers to the process an institute uses to evaluate the performance of teachers in classrooms. The process is essential for proper guidance and professional development of teachers. It seeks to improve the teachers' own practices by identifying strengths and weaknesses to further their professional development. This process helps improve the quality of teaching significantly. Thus, teachers' evaluation matters a lot to all the stakeholders; teachers, students, the management of an institute, the education authorities, and the state.

Class-observation is an essential tool for self-appraisal and self-development of teachers. Evaluation, either through peer observation or by a professional class observer, provides an opportunity for teachers to reflect on their methodology, communicative skills and their classroom environment.

This webinar is primarily designed to focus on aspects that are generally looked at in any class-observation and why teachers should consider these details while planning and teaching their classes. Establishing an effective teacher evaluation procedure is a challenging task. It requires establishing reference standards and evaluation criteria to allow a proper assessment of performance. The webinar will look into the different aspects of teachers' evaluation and seek to achieve consensus on developing workable criteria for teachers' evaluation.
