PART-A

Plan of Action for Session2011-12 and Result Achieved

A meeting Of Internal Quality Assurance Cell was organized on 30.07.2011 by the coordinator Dr. K.L.Meena,under the chairmanship of Prof. Babu Sahai Meena, principal of the college. An action plan to improve the quality circles in the college was discussed and outlined on the paper.

1. Teaching and learning activity is the main work of the college.To ensure the classes to be run everyday on time,a committee was formulated headed by prof. Jamuna Lal Meena,the senior faculty member of the college.The committee was empowered to take rounds frequently and submit its report everyday.

As a result,it was seen a tremendous improvement in the presence of students the classes.

2. The northside outer boundary of the college was destroyed here and there by some anti social elements.

It was decided to repair the boundary and a contract was given to Mr. Pooran Mali contractor, who completed the work within time

3. There is a disputed land in the college. The matter was decided in the favour of college by Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court and send it to DJ court Karauli. The IQAC took quick step to make boundary ball of the land, contact was made to Tehsildar and SDM Karauli, they send a team to survey and demark the land. Meanwhile the matter was again hanged in the court, therefore, the plan was not realised on ground.

4. The college has about 3000 students. At the time of admission, filling the exam forms, scholarship forms and supplementary exam forms, students have to go to collectory circle for photocopy.

IQAC took decision to provide photocopy facility to the students in the college premises. Therefore, side by student union office, a room was made available to Mr. Mahendra Sharma, Free of cost. He kept a photocopy machine in the room and all earning from it goes to him. So in the students interest, a PPP model was adopted successfully.

5. The IQAC decided to run a canteen in the college, in the outer building in front of Chemistry Department. Tenders were invited on nominal rent, canteen started but due to lack of sale,

it was proved a loss making job. Hence, the canteen closed upto end of the year.

6.The IQAC advised to auction grass of the college field in the rainy season and in winter Neem Tree which is a good fodder to animals.Both advices were appreciated by college administration,auction was made accordingly and earned an income by the college.

7. A Women's Hostel is under construction in the college by UGC grant of Rs.40 Lacs.The 1st installment of Rs.20 Lacs was utilized by the college.Hence,a committee headed by CDC director visited in July 2012 to make physical verification of the hostel and its report send to UGC in time.

8.A grant of Rs. 25.00 Lacs has provided by UGC to build a Golden Jubilee Memorial Hall against the proposal sent by the college. The 1st installment of Rs.12.5 Lacs was released by UGC and it was deposited in the PWD account.The work started in 2012.

9. Other construction works like PG Botany Classroom, 2 other class rooms, staircases and toilets were also started from UGC grant in 2012.The construction agency was PWD.

10.To maintain and cutting of Lawns,two electric cutter machines were purchased from Jaipur.

11. "Van Mahotsava" was organized in the college under guidance of District Collector and NSS in 2011. About 500 plants were rooted in the college. Some of them are demised and rests are alive still.

PART-B

The main goals of the institution are as follows-

2. To maintain and enhance the existing infrastructure of the college.

4. For faculty development encouraging teachers to participate in workshop, seminar, orientation and refresher courses and TRF.

8. To improve the situation of Kabaddi Ground, Basketball ground, Badminton court etc. and games & athletes activities.
9. Computer & Internet training to teachers.

Research Work

On 19.07.2011, Mr.Jamuna Lal Meena and Mrs.Rukmni Devi Meena were awarded TRF by UGC for Ph.D. They joined University of Kota &University of Rajasthan respectively to do the research work.

e-governance

The college is adopting e-governance system gradually.The payment of social welfare scholarship is deposited in bank accounts online. The web portal of Scholarship is working since 05.09.2012.The salary bills of staff,UGC payments &refund,IT return all are online.Fax and e-mail system is working in the college.

PMT/PET and Other Coaching Classes

This scheme was announced by Ex-Hr.Education Minister Dr.Jitendra Singh and impleted by commissioner college education Mr.Subir Kumar.Accordingly Government College Karauli has run these coaching classes from 25.02.2011 to17.03.2011.The expenditure of coaching classes was beared by development fund of the college.

When admission for coaching classes was announced, the coaching classes for PMT and PET couldn't be run due to lack of students. Only other coaching classes,that was common preparation like G.K.,Maths,English,Mental Ability,Reasoning and Education Psychology, were run in the college.

These coaching Classes were free for SC/ST students and paid classes for other students.Total admission in the coaching classes were 234 only.The category wise classification may be seen in the table given below:
