**Member Secretary Dr. Satish Saraswat** welcomed all the members in the first DLQAC, Kota Division meeting. He reviewed the NAAC status of all the colleges in Kota Division, as reported by the respective district nodal colleges. District wise analysis of the colleges was carried out as per the compiled data of the district.

**In Kota District**, 3 colleges have been accredited by NAAC, but two out of these have to enter the next cycle. 5 Colleges have to apply for 2(f) & 12(B) recognition by UGC and 8 colleges have to get NAAC accreditation.

**In Bundi District**, 2 college are NAAC accredited, only 1 Govt. Law College has to apply for 2(f) & 12(B) recognition.



In Baran District, 2 colleges are already NAAC accredited and 6 new college have to apply for 2(f) & 12(B).

In Jhalawar District, 2 colleges were NAAC accredited but have to enter the next cycle of accreditation so, all 7 colleges in the district have to be accredited by NAAC.

All the district nodal colleges were requested to expedite the process and all possible help was offered by the division level nodal centre. The district nodal college agreed to initiate the process immediately.


Dr. Shruti Gupta, Asstt. Director (RUSA) represented the RUSA directorate in the meeting. She asked the colleges to fill the spreadsheet regularly. She elaborated on the process of applying for NAAC accreditation and emphasized on the need and importance to fill the AQAR and AISHE data accurately. The information submitted in SSR and the IQA document may be matched with that of AISHE and AQAR and in case of any mismatch the college will be in trouble and would go down in grading.


