Student Feedback: Girls st	udents were pr	ovided feedba	ack forms to get	their		

response about College infrastructure and environment. The responses were good. A sample of 129 students were taken, in which their satisfaction scale regarding educational environment, faculties, library, infrastructure was good. Student feedback Analysis: Out of 129 students feedback 83 students i.e. 64.34 were highly satisfied by the academic facilities of the College. Regarding infrastructure facilities 54 of them were highly satisfied whereas, 68 of the students were satisfied by the library facility provided by the College. Parent Feedback Analysis: - On analysing the feedback forma provided by the parents, the reason for choosing the institution was quality education, qualified staff, better college administration was the main purpose for choosing the institution. - 69 of parents were satisfied with the academic environment of the College. - 95 of the parents recommended for competitive classes and remedial classes of their wards. - 64 parents demanded for canteen facilities and hygienic food for their wards. - Parents also recommended for opening P.G. in subjects likes Geography, Physics. - parents also demanded Economics, Sociology, Sanskrit, and English Literature at UG level. - After analysing feedback of parents and students, the College has decided to send the recommendations for opening new subjects at P.G. and U.G. level as demanded by the parents in the feedback.
