## **Response:**

The college has operational freedom in the implementation and optimum utilization of available physical and financial resources on the recommendation of college development committee. Grant received by the State Government, RUSA, UGC, and College Development Fund are the main financial sources for this purpose. The College takes direct initiative in the maintenance and upkeep of infrastructure and support facilities through the various committees constituted at the beginning of the academic session for effective planning and implementation. The college has permanent and contractual basis watchmen, gardeners, electricians, carpenters, plumbers and other employees for maintenance and repair of existing facilities.

For the maintenance of equipment, computers, photocopy machines, internet and other hardware's' services of external technical staff is hired on contract basis.

Alumni Association, social welfare associations, donors, corporate, banks etc, are also actively taking part in maintenance and development related activities by providing financial assistance as well as different items, plants, easy chairs and benches useful for college, students and staff members. For example recently 10 benches have been donated by PNB, Kotputli to the college. In front part of the college three gardens have been developed namely Charaak Garden, Aranya Garden and Harit Garden with variety of plant species. In science block one more garden is being developed for different species of herbs. Different committees have been constituted of staff members for effective monitoring and supervision of campus maintenance and infrastructure augmentation work. NSS volunteers, NCC Cadets, Rovers and Rangers are also involved in campus maintenance, through sanitation, plantation and other environment conservation related activities held throughout the year.

Laboratory: All the laboratories of respective departments are well equipped and maintained regularly. Zoology department has a vast collection of animal specimen along with a separate animal house. Botany department has a herbarium and Charak and Aranya gardens have been developed under the supervision of faculty of botany department. In chemistry department an advanced research laboratory is there in which research scholars are doing their research work. Laboratory assistants and lab boys help and support the faculty members and students during practical classes. Lab equipments are issued to students and collected back by lab staff to ensure their proper use. Logbooks and stock registers are maintained for chemicals, specimens, and equipments. Funds procured from State/Central Governments, UGC, Lab fee and RUSA are

utilized for lab maintenance. Electrically sensitive equipments are provided with necessary back up to ensure steady functioning in case of disruption in power supply, rooftop solar power panels having a capacity of 125 KVA functions as the substitute source.

Library: There is a central library with vast space having about 61734 books, 22 periodicals, 19 specific subject journals, and many Hindi and English news papers. The library is situated in main administrative block which includes one reading halls, three reference book halls and one librarian's office. Library facilities are available for students and faculty members from 9 am to 5 pm. Code of conduct has to be followed by students and faculty members while entering in the library and abide by the rules.. The whole library is facilitated with Wi-Fi network. The librarian not only monitors but also maintains the library infrastructure, funds, and utilization of funds. The library is equipped with 3 computers, CCTV cameras, one TV set, Multifunction Printer, Barcode Reader and one barcode machine. It is equipped with solar electric supply. Thirteen PG departments have their own library facilities. The library assistants and class four employees take care of books and other arrangements. There is an established system for physical verification of library each year by constituting different committees.

Sports: The college has adequate infrastructure of all sports events. There is a track for all athletics events. A well equipped high international standards indoor stadium of 60X40m, having synthetic (acrylic) surface laid over an Asphalt base has been constructed in the college campus under the khelo India Scheme of Government of India to promote and harness the sports skills among the rural students. Badminton, Table tennis, Carom and Chess indoor games facilities are there. Sports committee is working to conduct all trials and sports competition annually. It monitors the maintenance of playgrounds and sports events. There is a post of PTI but since his superannuation, the post is lying vacant.

Computers and Smart Classrooms: The College has a computer laboratory for students having 37 computers. The ICT lab is maintained and monitored by the ICT committee. Smart class room is equipped with digital podium, interactive board and projector etc. with Wi-Fi facility. External agencies are called in case of any repair beyond the scope of the system administrator or In-charge.

**Class Rooms:** The classrooms are well furnished and maintained by supporting staff.
