The primary purpose of research is to expand the existing body of knowledge by providing solutions to different problems in various fields of study.

This is amply visible in the vast areas of research being carried out in the College. The College boasts of many faculty members actively engaged in research in the faculty of arts, science and commerce.

One Project Fellow (Sh. Anil Kumar Bharti) worked on another Major Research Project, sanctioned by the DST, Rajasthan in the Department of Chemistry while another scholar (Ms. Pushpa Godwal, NET-JRF) continued working for her Ph.D. work in Chemistry. Three research scholars continued their doctoral work in the Department of Geography and two in the Department of Political Science. Another student (Ms. Deepika Chawla, RGNF) continued her work for her Ph.D. in the Department of E.A.F.M.A multitude of research papers were published in acclaimed journals.

The Departments of Chemistry and Political Science were granted the status of Research Centres of the University of Rajasthan.

In order to develop and encourage research, Academic leave is granted for attending conferences, seminars and workshops, both within and outside the State. Faculty members are encouraged to undertake major and minor research projects in collaboration with recognized government and non-government organizations. Young entrants to the profession are also motivated to go for their Ph.D. degrees in their chosen fields.
