


### Institutional Distinctiveness (2016-17)

The College boasts of many faculty members actively engaged in research in the faculty of arts, science and commerce. In order to develop and encourage research, Academic leave is granted for attending conferences, seminars and workshops, both within and outside the State. Faculty members are encouraged to undertake major and minor research projects in collaboration with recognized government and non-government organizations. Young entrants to the profession are also motivated to go for their Ph.D. degrees in their chosen fields. One student (Ms. Meenakshi Yadav) was awarded the Ph.D. degree of the affiliating University of Rajasthan, Jaipur in the subject of Chemistry while work on another Major Research Project, sanctioned by the DST, Rajasthan continued smoothly in the Department of Chemistry with the appointment of one Project Fellow (Sh. Anil Kumar Bharti). Another scholar (Ms. Pushpa Godwal, NET-JRF) continued working for her Ph.D. work in Chemistry. Three research scholars continued their doctoral work each in the Departments of Geography and Political Science. Another student (Ms. Deepika Chawla, RGNF) continued her work for her Ph.D. in the Department of E.A.F.M.A multitude of research papers were published in acclaimed journals.
