## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. To be punctual in classes and to stay for the entire class period because random arrivals and exits are disrespectful and distracting.
- 2. Every student must have an Identity card issued by the college and carry the ID on person and present it for inspection demand.
