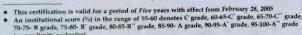

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)-2020-21

Students responded through feedback forms about curriculum, library facilities and administrative and other aspects. Questionnaire forms were collected from the students of different streams like Science, Arts and Commerce.

65-70 % students responded with an excellent for E-Content provided by the teachers on whats app groups and for the regular updates on college website. 60% students found that applied courses are excellent.

For the library and Administrative Aspects 80% students responded an Excellent conduction of NSS,NCC and YDC activities. 50% students demanded for the proper reading space in the library and 40% students observed that regular cleaning of class rooms is required.

Students of science stream were satisfied with laboratory studies and working condition of all laboratory equipment. Students response for the facilities available in the college was remarkable. 90-100% students were happy with the availability of safe drinking water, canteen and student welfare office in the college. 90% students demanded for the cleaning of toilets on regular basis. 75% students found that Institution strictly followed COVID-19 safety regulations.

Feedback from teachers was of mixed response for the curriculum. 85% teachers admitted to the need to revise the syllabus and 50% teachers responded that syllabus content truly fulfilled the need of the students.

70% teachers found Online classes through You tube channels and on whatsapp groups were beneficial for the students and also admitted that present curriculum enhanced the employability.
