Post graduate programmes in Hindi and Political science also inducted in the same scheme whereas M.A. Political science was overtaken by the govt. in 2013-14.

Alongside its rapid growth and development, the college retains a friendliness and warmth which has characterized the institution from its early days. With over 3000 students and more than 50 faculty and staff members, it offers Undergraduate programmes in Arts, Commerce & Science. This college aims to provide equal educational opportunities to the students from underprivileged families and is an initiative towards discharging social responsibility. The college increases community-consciousness on topics of social relevance like education, health, environment, rural development, female infanticide and female foeticide etc. through the efforts of talented students and staff of the college.

Curricular Aspects

SRP GOVT. COLLEGE BANDIKUI upholds the motto of ("ME MAN SHIV SANKALPAMASTU") That is "I owe to the welfare of all." in the realization of its vision of emancipation of the community through value-based holistic higher education. The college offers a plethora of courses - 3 UG and 2 PG programmes affiliated to University of Rajasthan Jaipur. The exposure of faculty in recent advances through participation in and organization of National/ International conferences, seminars, workshops, Refresher / Orientation courses and feedback from students, alumni and lectures of academic experts give the right impetus and direction for necessary changes in the curriculum.

Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

Admission to the programmes is by a transparent, well-administered mechanism, complying with all the norms of the concerned regulatory/governing agencies including state and central governments. The institution ensures equity and wide access by following the policy of Merit and is well represented by students from different geographical area and socio-economic, cultural and educational backgrounds.

The college has adequate in-built mechanisms which are continually updated to achieve the goals of academic excellence. The college plans and organizes teaching, learning and evaluation schedules by strictly following the Directorate College Education/University Academic Calendar, by maintaining academic diaries of the academic events and co-curricular activities and preparing its annual blue print of the academic events and co-curricular activities.

Fully aware of the extent and significance of institutional accountability in the teaching learning and evaluation process, individualized teachinglearning are conducted to cater to the broad spectrum of academic calibre of students admitted. Term tests are conducted to assess the academic needs of the students and slow learners and advanced learners identified through an analysis of the formative tests. Remedial classes are arranged to help the slow learners to adapt to the rigorous teaching learning process and to make credible academic progress.

The college maintains a student-centric and learner-centric atmosphere to achieve the desired learning outcomes. The teachers employ interactive and participatory approach creating a feeling of responsibility in learning and make learning a process of construction of knowledge. As an institution with around 40 years of service to the nation, the college has evolved an educational pattern with higher emphasis upon formative evaluation

Research, Extension and Collaboration

At present 2 PG departments are running in Political Science, Hindi. The college encourages its staff to take up research activities and engage in interdisciplinary and interdepartmental research activities. Some of our faculty members are approved research guides in different Departments of our institution in Political Science, Geography, Hindi, and Sanskrit. The college is under process to take recognition of Department of Political Science and Hindi as a research centre from University of Rajasthan.

First ever National Conference in the college on "Sahitya Sarjan Evam Prayavaran Sanrakshan" held on 12th -13th January 2016 of global magnitude and link them with local concerns. Eminent which is of national scientists, scholars, environmentalists and social activists shared the dais to deliberate on these issues of university importance. The college had the honour of playing host to the scholars from UP, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana & Delhi whose presence added an international dimension to the research activity.

The Mahavidyalay Vikas Samiti maintains the healthy relationship with all the stakeholders including Social bodies, NGOs and media to reach out to society.

The college has a wide range of Extension and outreach programmes (Educational, General and Specific) with special focus on the underprivileged and the vulnerable sections of society. The Extension Programmes namely NSS, NCC, YDC, Planning Forum, Scouts provide innumerable opportunities to students to reach out to society and people who are oppressed, powerless and disadvantaged. Campaigns are regularly held by the organizations like NCC, NSS, YDC, Scouts and all departments for mass sensitization on issues such as gender inclusion and environment.

To make the campus eco-friendly rain water harvesting, and plantation programmes are conducted. Students opting for NSS and NCC get credits on completion of these programmes.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources

Infrastructure facilities are the key for effective and efficient conduct of the educational programmes. The Institution has 20 Rooms, 5 labs and a computer lab ICT enabled. The college ensures optimal utilization of budget allocated for the maintenance and upkeep of the college infrastructure by holding regular meetings of various bodies /committees constituted to plan and monitor the projects to be taken up in a session.

ICT Facilities

The NEP 2020 emphasizes the use of ICT in Higher Education. Our institute uses the latest technologies in daily routine work and in teaching - learning practices, competently. Previous visit of NAAC team pinned down the limited use of ICT as a weakness of the College. Since then, we have paid special attention to develop ICT and make it our distinctive institutional feature. The institute has its own recognition as ICT centre for CCE Rajasthan. institutional ICT approaches are catalogued below:

At present, the institute boast about a well-developed IT infrastructure that includes Wi-Fi campus, CCTV cameras, smart class, well-furnished E-class, Computer lab, , library, reading room, all the departments and IQAC, NCC, NSS, ISDC cells, internet connectivity. The AC cooled seminar hall of institute, having capacity of 100 persons, is well equipped with ICT Facilities such as e-podium, Computer, Mike system, Projector, Projector screen.

Student Support and Progression

The diverse programmes in academics and co-academics as well as in sports, cultural and scientific activities are well synchronized and reinforced with an effective support system to produce enlightened and self-reliant students as visualized in the vision and mission of the college. - 4. Science faculty is under SFS scheme where students pay more fee then govt run courses. Funds from UGC can also be not utilized in these labs.
- 5. Courses run under SFS scheme should be overtaken by the govt. so that problem of funds as well as experienced faculty may be solved.
- 6. As the college is Situated about 3 km from the town and there is on internal transport available for the college hence the attendance remains lesser than 90 %

- 1. Fostering partnerships with other organizations getting research grants from funding agencies to support the research initiatives.
- 2. Introducing more programmers with a better fit between academic value and societal
- 3. Attracting more donors, finance from MP, MLA's, fund, donation from business houses.
