Subject: Establishment of new Government Polytechnics at Sawai Madhopur and Sirohi and one Girls' Polytechnic at Ajmer.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.F. 6(15)TE/88 dated 25.5.1988 on the subject mentioned above and to say that sanction in principle has been issued for setting up of two new Government Polytechnics at Pali and Chittorgarh and one new Girls' Government Polytechnic at Bikaner.

2. Your proposals for establishment of two Government Polytechnics at Sawai Madhopur and Sirohi with Mechanical and Electronic Engineering courses in each with annual intake of 30 students each and one Government Girls' Polytechnic at Ajmer with Electronics and Computer Science course with annual intake of 30 students each are under active consideration of the All India Council for Technical Education.

In order to enable the All India Council for Technical Education/convey its approval in the matter, the State Government is requested to make an additional provision of Rs.100.00 lakhs in the current year (1988-89) under the State Plan by re-appropriation in respect of these three polytechnics and intimate the same to the All India Council for Technical Education for processing the case. Further necessary action in the matter will be taken only on receipt of this confirmation about the availability of additional plan provision of Rs.100.00 lakhs for the purpose.
