(A) Code of Conduct for Students: -

Code of Conduct for Students

- Students must maintain discipline; in case of violation disciplinary action would be taken.
- Should be polite, respectful and well mannered.
- It is expected that a healthy and decent relationship is exhibited among all students.
- Once the student enters the premises, they should have a concern towards each and every property, like handling of furniture, caring for plantations etc.
- Whenever the students are free from classes they are advised to use the library or engage themselves in some extra or co-curricular activities.
- When in the campus students should always have with them their college i-cards
- Ragging and eve-teasing is totally taken as a serious offence and students are advised not to indulge in any such activities.
- Students must stay away from anti-social activities.
- The campus must be kept clean .Students should refrain from scribing on walls and black boards.
- Consumption of tobacco in any form, drug etc. is completely prohibited.
- Indulging in malpractices during examinations is taken as a serious offence.
- Zooming on vehicles is completely restricted.

(B) Code of Conduct for the Teaching Staff: -

1. Every teacher has to obey the orders of the Principal of the college.
2. Teachers are expected to be present on the college campus at least 30 minutes before any examinations start in the college campus for which his/her duty is assigned.
3. Teachers should sign the attendance register while reporting for duty.
4. All meetings of the teachers shall be held only after 2.30 PM and not during class hours.
5. Staff members are encouraged to publish articles and present papers in seminar and class room.
6. All staff will adhere strictly to the rules and regulations of the college.

(C) Code of Conduct for Non-Teaching Staffs: -

1. Every staff member has to obey the order of the Principal of the college.
2. Non-Teaching staff must report in time to duty as per the working hours.
3. Non-Teaching staff shall not leave the college premises without permission before 5.30 PM.
4. Non-Teaching staff assigned to laboratories should keep the lab clean, maintain the equipment properly and help the teachers during practical classes.
5. Every Non-Teaching staff reports to duty at least 30 minutes in advance.
6. All staff will adhere strictly to the rules and regulations of the college.
