## IQAC Minutes of the Meeting

A meeting of the IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) was held in the office of the Principal today on 1.08.2016 at 1.30 PM.

The following issues and points were discussed in the meeting. A plan of action was also chalked out for the upcoming session 2016-2017.

1. The examination results of Maharaja Ganga Singh University, Bikaner were declared, making the college proud of the performances of its students. Overall result of 2016 examinations was 90.1%. Out of 2774 students, 2499 students passed the examinations.
2. The college has done a commendable job in acting as the District Nodal College for the disbursement of CM Scholarship Scheme. In 2015-16, 3478 students received scholarships, and an amount of one crore sixty seven lakh eighty two thousand rupees was distributed. Our college faculty performed extremely well in the whole process.
3. In the upcoming session, apart from the participation of our faculty in the extra curricular activities of the college, we shall encourage them to take up research activities more actively. Presently, an amount

1 lakh 20 thousand has been received from UGC, Bhopal for the MRP of Mr. Mahesh Raikar, TA grant for the Malaysia tour of Dr. N. R. Kaswan and TRF grant for Ph.D for Dr. S. S. Khinchwale also been received.

4. The organization of a National / International Seminar is also proposed this year to enhance the active participation of the faculty in research and organizational activities.
5. Under the RUSA scheme of the Central government, an amount of 2 crore has been sanctioned for our college (January 2016), under which 70 lakh has to be spent on new construction, 70 lakh on renovation work and 60 lakh on books and equipment.
6. The College has received a grant of 50 lakh rupees for new construction (March 2016) from the government. BOG and PMU Committees working under RUSA Committee have initiated the detailed planning of construction work. PWD Engineers have been

contacted, plan of 8 small classrooms is almost ready and construction will soon begin, so we hope to have 6 technology equipped classrooms in this session.

7. It is proposed that under the supervision of the College Development Committee, an iron fencing needs to be done from the main gate of the college to the inner gate. It is also proposed that the flooring of the administrative block needs to be repaired/replaced.

8. For the welfare of the students, Sports Committees and other Committees like Literary, Cultural, NSS etc. should organize productive and interesting activities in the campus to promote the participation of the students.

9. Initiatives would be taken for more plantation to make the campus greener.

The following was discussed in the meeting:

1. After the receipt of Rs. 50 lakh under the PUSA grant, 6 new classrooms are under construction opposite the college hall. The work in progress is being looked after by BOG and PMU collaboratively.
2. College Development Committee (Mahavidyalaya vias Samiti) took up several developmental works during the past 6-8 months. As proposed in the beginning of the session, iron fencing was accomplished from the main gate of the college to the inside campus gate. Floor tiles and other repair work was done in the Administrative Block. 100 chairs and 100 tables were purchased for students. 8 steel almirahs were purchased for faculty. A grass cutter machine worth Rs. 30,000 was purchased for the maintenance of lawns. A new water hut was installed near the canteen for the residents.

3. Teaching faculty contributed enthusiastically financially and physically in plantation of the college to make it greener and more beautiful.
4. As a consequence of the motivation of the members of the IQAC and Research Cell, a number of our faculty members took part in research activities. This enthusiasm has to be boosted in the coming days also.
5. There was a plethora of extra-curricular activities in the campus in almost all fields. The winners in these activities and sports tournaments to be awarded and appreciated in the upcoming Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony.
6. It was a proud moment for the institution to host a National Seminar on "Human Rights and Globalisation" on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017, in which eminent scholars and speakers from JNU, DU, Rajasthan University, JNV Jodhpur participated and exchanged their views.
