### Introduction

Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Government College, Sri Ganganagar is a pioneer co-educational institution in the region to provide opportunities of education to students coming from rural and economically weaker sections of the society in and around Sri Ganganagar. It was initially established as a Secondary School in 1939 by Maharaja Ganga Singh. It was promoted to an Intermediate College in 1946, and graduated to a higher seat of learning in 1954 as Graduation College in Arts and in 1960 with Graduation in Science. The Post-Graduation studies began in the college in 1968. The name of the college was changed from Government College to Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Government College in 2009 by the orders of the State Government. The college was initially affiliated to University of Rajasthan, Jaipur; in 1987 the affiliation was shifted to M.D.S. University, Ajmer. Later on by the orders of the Government of Rajasthan, it was affiliated to the University of Bikaner (presently named as Maharaja Ganga Singh University, Bikaner) in 2003.
