

## IQAC REPORT 2021-2022

This year IQAC has undertaken various activities to ensure quality enhancement in teaching and learning. Following activities were conducted during the academic year.

- IQAC, in collaboration, of the Department of English conducted one day workshop on Critical Thinking in Classrooms on July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. Dr. SOnu Shiva, Associate Professor, English, Govt. Dungar College, Bikaner resourced the workshop. The workshop intended to develop critical thinking and multilayer interpretation of a text in the classrooms. 41 faculty members participated in the workshop.
- On July 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, the Department of English conducted Two Days Workshop on Language proficiency and Personality Grooming. Dr. Sonu Shiva, Associate Professor, English, Dungar College was the resource person for the workshop. 15 faculty members participated in the workshop and learnt to develop their speaking skills. At the same time the participants were also exposed to various strategies that can increase students participation in classes.
- A workshop on Intellectual property Rights was conducted by IQAC on 12.02.2022. 168 participants were registered in the workshop. Dr Manoj Balan explained the concepts of patenting, logo, trademark, copyright act, etc. in details.
- District Level Workshop on Data Presentation and Publication in Research was organized by IQAC on April 1<sup>st</sup>,2022. Key Note speakers were Dr. Smita Sharma, Associate Professor, Dungar College Bikaner and Dr. S.K. Verma, Assistant professor, Dungar College, Bikaner. 170 participants from various colleges of the district registered for the workshop.
- IQAC Conducted Online Training on AQAR preparation on 13.01.2021 in collaboration with Commissionerate College Education, Rajasthan and SLQAC. Dr Divya Joshi was the key-note speaker. Ms. Suchi Tyagi, Dr Vimlesh Soni and Dr Suchi Gupta cleared the doubts regarding AQAR filling.
- Bakery workshop was organized by the Department of Home Science and IQAC on 11.04.2022-13.042022. Ms. Jyoti Satija resourced the workshop. Participants learnt art of baking cakes, cookies, pastries etc.
- The Department of Home Science in collaboration of IQAC conducted one day seminar on 08.04.2022. The seminar was entitled New Trends in Home Science. Students of PG and UG of Home Science participated in the seminar.

- A Seminar for UG and PG students of Department of English was Conducted on 24.03.2022. The topic was “Shakespeare: A Man of all Ages”. 23 students participated in the seminar and 16 presented papers. Best papers were selected amongst the total papers.
- The Department of English conducted a Two Week Online Course on English Language Skills for Better Communication, in collaboration with Directorate, College Education, Rajasthan from 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 – 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2021. The course was free of cost for students. Faculty from various universities through out the nation delivered lecture in the course. More than 200 students were benefitted in the course.
- A short term offline course on Basics of Spoken English and Personality Grooming was conducted by the Department of English from 29.11.2021 to 08.12.2021. 15 students participated in the course and benefitted. This was an activity based course and students learnt language learning strategies through various interesting activities.

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
