Dr. Dhirendra Devarshi:

- In the pending issues of previous session, the dates may be mentioned for their implementation.

- The activities of IQAC should be highlighted in the college magazine.

- In continuation of the A&A process of 3rd cycle of NAAC, the areas may be identified where College secured less marks and those should be worked upon with.

- A "No Vehicle Day" may be observed at the college once in a month.
- For the proposed demolition of four damaged rooms of college, the services of some external agencies may be sought to cut the cost of this task.
- In the under construction Indoor Stadium of college, a channel gate should be mounted to prevent untoward activities of intruders.
- The syllabi are changing as per NEP. The BOS members of college may identify different electives for their subjects to be proposed for forthcoming BOS Meetings.
- For the Monkey menace, the notification may be written at walls and Press Note may be given for not feeding monkeys in and around college premises.
- New PCs and Printers should regularly be added to cope up with the fast-changing technologies.
- Mentors should collect the "Progression Data" by getting the feedback form filled by outgoing students.
