ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Government Bangur college, Didwana is witness for the educational uplift of the whole region since 1951. It was educational centre of Inter College from 1951 and of U.G. level from 1958. This college was up graded to P.G. level in 1981 and is recognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi under (2f) and 12(B). Presently the college is having education in 18 subjects covering science, arts and commerce streams. It is a co-education institution with over 4855 students. The college is permanently affiliated to the M.D.S.U., Ajmer. The college has several programmes for skill development, quality enhancement and over all personality development under the aegis of NSS, NCC and Women Cell for the students. For quality teaching-learning process, the college is equipped with interactive smart board, broadband connectivity, Wi-Fi zones and INFLIBNET access. Since its inception the college has been keeping pace with the changing needs and requirements to meet its academic growth by augmenting infrastructural facilities.

The college is committed for over-all development of the students through the five core values: **Contributing to National Development, Fostering Global Competencies, Inculcating a Value System, Promoting the Use of Technology and Quest for Excellence;** which form the foundation for assessment of institutions that volunteer for accreditation by NAAC. The main objective of the institution is to impart value based quality higher education to the students. The institution is doing effort to raise standard of teaching through value based education. The spirit and motto of the college is embedded in its logo - **‘Uthisthata Jagarat Prapaya Varanni Bodhat’** (उत्तिष्ठत जाग्रत प्राप्य वरान्निबोधत) {कठोपनिशद् 1.3.4.} which means Awake, Arise and not stops till the Goal is achieved; famous quotation of Swami Vivekananda. The experienced, dedicated and devoted teaching and non-teaching staff of the college is committed to provide healthy learning environment to its students. Healthy Teacher - Students relationship and collective committed efforts of all members of this institute helped this college to be accredited as B + by NAAC in year 2006 and with CGPA of 2.68 on four point scale at B grade in year 2016(In NAAC accreditation -Cycle: II).

The college is known after its galaxy of alumni's spread over entire country and also at abroad. The academic environment is excellent amongst the educational institutes of the region. The curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities are commendable in this college. Geology is taught in this college up to post graduate level and the alumni of this department have gone far and wide in different parts of World and up to Antarctica. The backbone of the institute is its library housing more than sixty five thousands of books. The gigantic hostel building is capable to house 55 students. Girl's hostel building has been constructed with the help of U.G.C; capable to house 40 students. The NCC wing cadets of our institute participated in Republic day parades at New Delhi. Three units of NSS volunteers also work commendable. Our students also excel in the fields of Sports and Literary. The state level annual Seth Narayan Das Bangur memorial intercollegiate Hindi debate competition organized since 1972-73 has its own reputation and produce numbers of good debaters. This debate is sponsored by "*Bangur Gharana*" and is considered as one of the best practice of our college but due to COVID-19 pandemic; it was not organized during the session.

The rural background of majority of the students does not hinder much to reach students up to highest level because of the family environment existing in the campus between officers, officials, students and their parents. IQAC and Alumni association is actively looking after for the development of the college.


