- 5. **Safety and Security:**
 - Hire security guards to maintain campus safety.
 - Restrict entry of unauthorized persons within the college premises.
- 6. **Community Engagement:**
 - Conduct outreach programs like career counseling and scholarships for economically weaker sections.
 - Encourage active participation in academic, social, and environmental initiatives.
