CODE OF CONDUCT- STUDENTS

1. Students must be punctual and regular in attending classes, tutorials, class tests examinations etc. Failure to obtain the required attendance percentage, non submission of assignments and unjustified absence from internal assessments etc. will be treated as breaching the code of conduct.

2. Use of mobile phone during class hours and examinations is prohibited and is liable for punishment.

3. The fact of employment or business etc. during a course is to be communicated with complete information to the college.

4. Participate actively in all activities of the college including competitions, cultural programs etc.

5. Students are to participate in court visits, moot court, legal aid camps organized by the college.

6. Follow the dress code in college.

7. Keep yourself informed about the important decisions of the High Courts and Supreme Court.

8. No posters are to be pasted or fixed with cellotape anywhere on the college walls. Any writing, scribbling on the walls will attract disciplinary measures against the student.

9. The college is a tobacco-free institution. Smoking, chewing and spitting tobacco products or pan masala, consumption of alcohol or narcotic drugs is strictly prohibited. Appropriate disciplinary action will be taken and punishment will be imposed as per law.

10. Students must refrain from mishandling and tampering with property of the college, library books or college computer systems.

11. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken and punishment will be imposed according to relevant rules.
