

RAIN WATER HARVESTING

Water is a precious commodity in Rajasthan. We at Govt college, Pushkar have initiated a good practice of harvesting water in the college premises. In the month of June and July, when monsoon sets in, water is in abundance. So, to harness the flowing rain waters from rooftops n pipes, efforts were made to let this water percolate in the soil or get accumulated in tank, resulting in optimum use of rain water.

To initiate this, down pipes were laid n connected with the pipes coming from rooftops to help carry the water to the tank near the borewell. Also, pipes were laid to discharge water into the soil to recharge groundwater. Water that will get accumulated in the tank will further help for plants in the garden as rainwater is free from chemicals.

The water harvesting project undertaken by the college is at its nascent stage, but with other development projects being taken up in the college will definitely improve the system n cater to the mission undertaken by the college for water conservation.
