

	S. D. Govt. College is working tirelessly to benefit, educate and promote girl's education. Beawar is surrounded by small villages on its outskirts, like Jawaja, kharwa, Mangliawas and many more. As it is a P. G. College, girls from distant places also come here for education. Girls from Jaitaran, Neemach, Bar, Sojat, Pali, Rajsamand are some of these places. The girls from these places come from rural background, where education is at the back seat. So motivating the girls to come regularly was a big challenge.				



S. D. Govt. College, Beawar is co- education institute, where boys and girls study together. To provide a healthy and a fearless environment for the girls was also bit challenging, but the increase in number of girl student's admission reflects a positive picture.

The Practice:

The institute laid emphasis on the overall personality development of the students, especially girls. Most of the girls those who come to college are bit shy and suffer from forced introvert personality. "Forced introvert" in a way, that they come from rural backgrounds where speaking out our own views is strongly discouraged.

To impart education that girls become self-dependent and grow as a confident and courageous women. Many literary and cultural activities are being organized in the college where girls get equal chance as boys to participate. The college promotes gender equity and teaches the same. Topics covered on gender equity as mentioned in syllabus are being taught to students, so they become a youth



with a vision of equality.

Skill development: Various activities are conducted by Women Cell where the girls get a chance to show their talent during various activities such as "Mehndimaking" "Rangoli "Best out of waste" card making and others. The girls also learn these skills and may use it for their source of income.

Social values and responsibilities: The college-management is dedicated to raise students who understand their responsibilities, rights and duties and learn moral values .The NCC and NSS wing plays an important in this regard. The NCC has its own girls wing (Army). The girls enthusiastically get enrolled in the NCC. The NCC (Girls) wing aims at developing character, comradeship, a secular outlook, discipline, ideals of selfless services and the spirit of adventure in girls. The success of the training program can be seen, as one of our Girl NCC cadets got a chance to be a part of the Republic Day Parade at New Delhi.

The NSS wing: Both the boys and girls are equally eager to join NSS. Here in NSS wing students learn how to carry out social responsibilities with co-ordination with other fellow students.

Various competition are been held during the seven day camps where girls and boys participate with full enthusiasm.

"Beti padhao, Beti bachao":

To spread the message of "Save girl child- Stop female foeticide" and "Educate girl", Rallies were conducted and awareness campaigns were conducted. The College management and the faculty members joined hands together to create awareness about the aforesaid. Dr. Deepali Lal, the head of the dept. of Zoology actively participated in the mission.

Main highlights of the campaign were:

"Beti padhao, Beti bacchao" Maanav Shrinklaa

 Collaboration with a well-known college of Beawar- Vardhmaan Girls College to spread the message of girl education.

- Mass oath taking to prevent female foeticide.
- Talks, webinars and seminars:

Doctors and well known personalities are invited to guide girls on health and hygiene and other topics like "Good touch-bad touch".

An amount (around 15 thousand) is reserved for purchase of books meant especially for SC girls.



Problems encountered and resources required: Raising fund for conducting activities was the main problem encountered, which was tackled nicely by contribution of staff members and others.

Keeping the girls motivated to come to college regularly and attend all the classes daily was also a challenging task but proper guidance and counseling helped a lot in overcoming the problem.

NOTES:

- The girls of our college are doing wonders by shining brightly in the merit list of M.D.S. University, Ajmer of most of the subjects.
- Every year around 10-14 girl students avail the benefit of "Kaali Bheel Medhavi Yojna" and "Devnarayan Gurjar Scooty Yojna" run by the government.
- All the girls' education is exempted from fees in the college, as per government rules.
