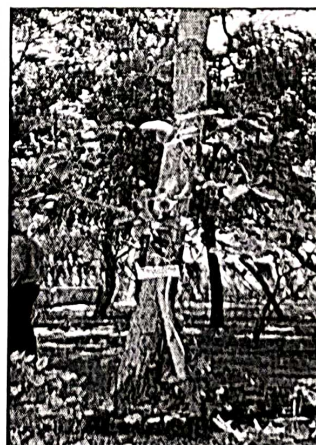
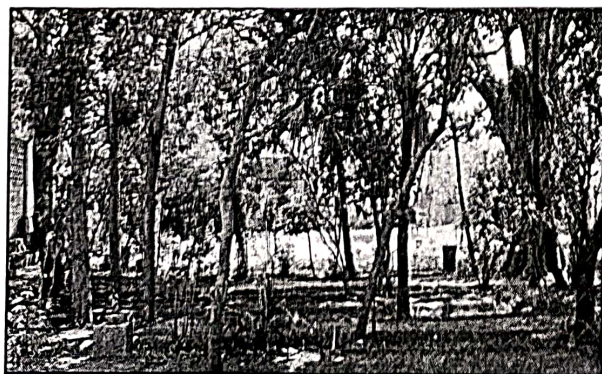
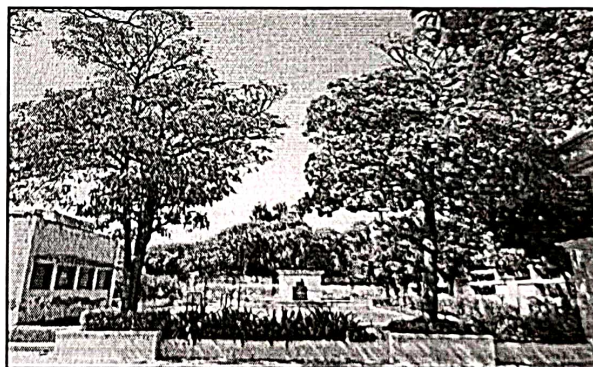
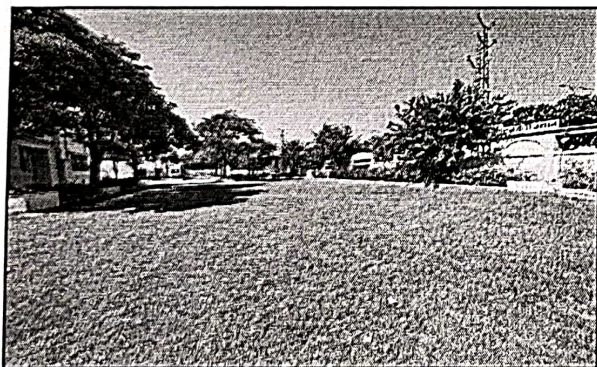
Green Audit Report

Shri Ratanlal Kanwarlal Patni Government PG College Kishangarh is situated 26.51 N latitude and 74.92 E longitude of the central Aravalli Region of Rajasthan. It is a big college with approximately 5000 students. College is situated in the heart of the city Kishangarh in front of Gundolav Lake.

Green plants play an important role to enhance environmental quality by reducing pollution, which is very beneficial for health & also add glamour to the glimpse of the college. It gives every living being a suitable environment to grow, work and multiply.

Out of total 58274.78 sqm. of college campus area maximum open area is covered with various plants to make it green & environment friendly by planting many native and ornamental plants species. Green cover of college campus is spread among different zones namely **Saraswati Garden** located in front of college building, **Botanical Garden** at the back of college, **Subash Garden** in the right-hand side of college entrance.

Botanical Garden is situated in the department of Botany in the old college building with plants of different categories viz, pteridophyte, gymnosperm and angiosperm. This garden is managed and maintained by the botany department of the college. It provides major resource of plant material required for practical, scientific studies, display collection, demonstration and education. Plants are labeled by their common names and botanical names. Gardens in the college campus are maintained by R.K. Marble Group, college staff and students themselves.

Different Plantation programme were organized in the guidance of head of institution i.e., college Principal under the banner of National Cadet Core (NCC) National Service Scheme (NSS), Rover and Ranger, Women Cell etc.

Different types of ornamental plants including Neruin, China Rose, were planted in Gandhi Vatika on 8th august 2020 by NSS, NCC & Rover and Ranger.

In the year 2019 a drive was conducted by the state government for the plantation of state tree 'Rohida'. In the compliance of above on 14 August 2019 Rohida Plants was planted in the botanical garden under the scheme "Green campus clean campus" a plantation programme was organized on 16th July 2019. Under 'Harit Rajasthan' campaign - "Ek Chatra Ek Vriksha Yojna" an intensive plantation programme was organized on 26 July 2019. On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, a plastic free campaign was organized on 2 October 2019 to reduce non- decomposable solid waste in college campus. In this Programme every student planted one or more tree to enhance environmental qualities of college campus. Rover and Ranger along with college staff conducted a plantation programme on 9 July 2018.

On 15 July 2017 on the occasion of 'Vishva Kaushal Divas' cleanliness and plantation programme was carried out. Under the banner of NSS plantation was also done on 29 July 2019. Prior to that a fortnight cleanliness Swachhata Pakhwada was organized from 01 to 15 august 2017.

Many of us know about so many plants of ornamental, economic and medical values but are unable to identify them in nature. Owing to this a few important plants were selected and named. A name plate was made for each of them. With local name and botanical name and planted on them for student's convenience.

Every year under the banner of NCC, NSS and Rover & Ranger an intensive plantation and cleanliness programme is organized.

Two compost pits were dug in the college campus, which are used to prepare compost from plant litter, the prepared compost is used in gardening for the enhancement of soil quality and increase fertility it also helps to reduce the waste. Use of degradable biowaste increases cleanliness provide nutrients, moisture etc.

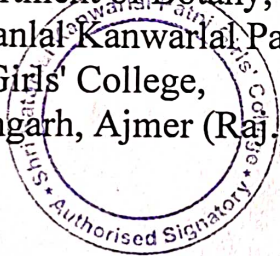
Certificate - Green Audit

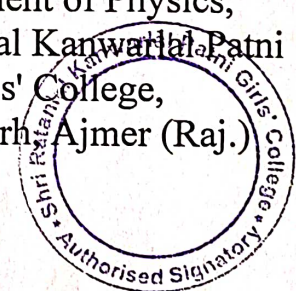

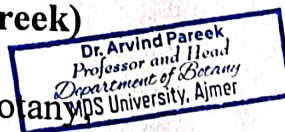
