CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- ❖ Every student must behave with courtesy and respect with teachers, staff, all students and visitors.
- ❖ Every student must refrain from using derogatory language, engaging in bullying or harassment, or discriminating against others based on their race, ethnicity, gender, religion, sexual orientation.
- ❖ Students are expected to come to college dressed suitably maintaining decency.
- ❖ Every student must wear and display visibly her identity card while being present in the college premises.
- ❖ Students must be seated in their classrooms at the beginning of each period. They must not enter or leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher.
- ❖ Every student must complete all assignments, exams, and projects with honesty and integrity.
- ❖ Students are expected to maintain the general cleanliness within the classroom, laboratories and the college campus in general and avoid using non-degradable plastics.
- ❖ Students should handle the college properties with care. Damage of furniture or any other material may lead to penalty or suspension from the College.
- ❖ Students should take due cognizance with regard to the conservation of Water, Energy and Environment.
- ❖ During leisure hours students are advised to use the library as much as possible.
- ❖ Do not engage in cheating, copying, or any form of academic dishonesty.
- ❖ Use of cell phones is strictly prohibited during the class hours.
- ❖ Students must refrain from mishandling and tampering with library books or college computer systems.
- ❖ Students are forbidden from inviting friends from other institutions and outsiders to the College.
- ❖ The right to access Girl's Common Room is reserved to girls.
- ❖ Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate this rule.
