Students Satisfaction Survey Report (2021-2022)

The students play a crucial role in the institution, and to gather their experiences for the academic session 2021-2022, a questionnaire comprising 15 parameters was prepared. The students filled out the questionnaire both online and offline, providing anonymous responses. The survey covered various aspects, including institute-level feedback on infrastructure and learning experiences. The main goal of the survey was to aid the institution in achieving its objectives and identifying areas that require improvement.

A total of 252 students responded to the Student Satisfaction Survey, but only 237 complete questionnaires were considered for analysis after excluding 15 incomplete ones. The responses were then graphically represented. The findings indicated that a majority of the students were satisfied with the Teaching and Learning process, as they were provided with diverse opportunities to participate in academic and extracurricular activities. However, some students suggested that there is room for improvement in the use of ICT by certain teachers.




Is drinking water facility available in the college?




Whether there is enough teaching staff to teach in the college or not




Whether classes are conducted regularly in the college or not






Are you satisfied with the facilities of sports ground and sports equipments available in the college?




Is drinking water facility available in the college?




Is the facility of girl's common room available in the college?

Conclusion - The summary report based on the students' responses revealed high satisfaction levels in various aspects, such as facilities, infrastructure, syllabus coverage, grievance redressal, course outcomes, and related activities. The students also expressed appreciation for the implementation of a learning outcome-based curriculum, including effective teacher-student communication and teaching methodologies.

According to the final summary report, approximately 94% of the students showed satisfaction with the overall pedagogy, infrastructure, and facilities in the college, while 2% expressed dissatisfaction, and 4% remained neutral. The overall Student Satisfaction Index (SSI) of the college was found to be around 95%.

The survey also highlighted certain concerns raised by the students, including the need for a canteen facility on campus, increased industrial visits and interactions with industries, better arrangements for internships, more high-quality guest lectures and workshops, an expanded library with more books, improved IT facilities with Wi-Fi access, and the introduction of additional postgraduate courses.
