STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT (2020-21)

Veer Bala Kalibai Govt. Girls College, Dungarpur is affiliated with Govind Guru Tribal University, Banswara. The college offer various courses like B.Com., B.A., and B.Sc. at Under Graduation level and M.A., Sociology at Post-Graduation level. Presently, over 1600 students are studying in college. Faculties of the College have continuously been working on quality improvement and the betterment of student learning experiences. In order to analyze the lag areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from students have been received. This report focuses on the feedback of students on Syllabus, Teachers and Infrastructure. For this purpose, a feedback form was designed and filled by the students. Total 125 responses have been received and analyzed. An effort was made to access the student feedback on teachers. Questions were asked to the student on the various aspects like teacher's regularity, class preparation, guidance and mentoring, etc. It was observed that, about 96% students feel that, teachers were very good at maintaining the regularity to the class. 81% (51% completely agree and 41% agreed) agrees that they complete their syllabus on time. Most of the students (86%) consider their teachers are well-versed in their subject knowledge and are having good behavior (95%) towards students. The analysis clearly indicates that teachers encourage their students for the active participation in class and other activities.

Question number 12 explains the students' response about the role of extracurricular and cultural activities in the overall development of the students. Almost 92 % students completely agree or agree on this point. Almost 39.2 % students completely agree on the point that library and its regular use is essential for the students. Question 15 to 21 reveals the data related with the educational atmosphere, level of cleanliness, availability of games and extracurricular activities in the college. The graph clearly indicates that maximum number of students is very much satisfied with most of the aspects. Only thing the college needs to improve more on is the cleanliness. About 40 percent of students were dissatisfied with the cleaning in the college. The data analysis also shows the college conducts NSS activities well, which gives students more chances to get involved in their community.
