After analyzing the feedback some assertions can be made about the teaching learning outcomes:

Students feel proud to be enrolled in the best government college of Alwar district as a regular student thus indicating their preference and consideration. They take pride in being part of the district nodal college with 8 PG departments, Ph.D research centre of RRBMU Alwar and a better equipped college in terms of resources and facilities.

- 1. Students felt highly contended with the teaching faculty and teaching.
