ALWAR AT A GLANCE

Alwar state is a princely state established in 1770 by a Kachwaha Rajput named Pratap Singh. Presently, Alwar is a district headquarter in the State of Rajasthan. It is located 150 km South of Delhi and 150 km North of Jaipur. Alwar is also known as Gateway of Rajasthan and was designated as a part of the National Capital Region, resulting in additional development projects, including Delhi-Mumbai Freight Corridor, Delhi-Mumbai National Mega highway Project, Rapid Rail Project etc.

According to 2011 census, the population of Alwar district was 3674,179. The city is a heritage drawing tourists at Sariska National Tiger Project, Bhangarh Fort, Bharatrihari Temple, Neemrana Fort Palace, Dadikar Fort, Bala Quila etc. As far as economy of Alwar is concerned, agriculture has been main contribution to its GDP. Industrial areas at Bhiwadi, Khushkhera, MIA and Neemrana have put their identity on International map. The total geographical area of the district is 782897 hectares which is 2.5 percent of the total area of Rajasthan. Alwar is also emerging as an education hub. As a part of it Raj Rishi Bharatrihari Matsya University was established in 2012-13. ESI Medical College has become operational from this year and Government Medical College has to come up soon.



COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

SITUATED in the Aravali hills, the historical city of Alwar has shown continual progress in the field of education. To impart higher education to his subjects, Maharaja Raj Rishi Dev Jai Singh established Raj Rishi College here on 2nd October 1930. It came into existence as an Intermediate College, but in the year 1945, it was upgraded to a Graduate College having faculties in Arts and Commerce. Keeping in view the growing strength of students, with every succeeding year, Rajrishi College was bifurcated in 1978-79 into two separate colleges - 'Rajrishi College' with Science and Commerce faculties and 'Government Arts College' with Arts and Law faculties. In the year 1999, Govt. Arts College was renamed after Babu Shobha Ram, one of the luminaries of the Mewat area. He was the first and the only Prime Minister of the Matsya State, the hero of the 'Praja Mandal Movement' and Indian 'freedom fighter' as well. He was the first Revenue Minister of Govt. of Rajasthan. The Government of Rajasthan thought it appropriate to name one of the leading educational institutions of the state after him.



BSR Government Arts College gradually emerged as one of the leading educational institutes of Rajasthan. The Mewat area has long been known for its communal amity and cultural heritage to which Babu Shobha Ram Govt. Arts College, Alwar is a valuable addition. It is hoped that in the years to come, this institute will take its rightful place among the premier institutes of this country where the youth may receive value-enriched academics along with encouragement to explore life with all its surprises and adventures. Every year the college enrolls more than 5000 students in its 08 PG Departments and 02 UG Departments. The college has research facilities in 10 different subjects of humanities.
