COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

Situated in the Aravalli Hills, the historical city of Alwar has exhibited continuous progress in the field of education. To impart higher education to his subjects, Maharaja Raj Rishi Dev established Raj Rishi College here on October 02, 1930. It came into existence as an Intermediate College and was upgraded to Graduate level in 1945 having faculties in Arts and Commerce. Keeping in view the growing strength of students with time, the Raj Rishi College was bifurcated in 1978-79 into two separate colleges - "Raj Rishi College" with Science and Commerce faculties and "Government Arts College" with Arts and Law faculties. In the year 1999, Govt. Arts College was renamed after Babu Shobha Ram, one of the luminaries of the Mewat area in which this college situated. He was also the first Prime Minister of the Matsya State, the hero of the 'Praja Mandal Movement' and a 'Freedom Fighter' as well. Therefore the Government of Rajasthan thought it appropriate to name this educational institution after him.

Babu Shobha Ram Government Arts College gradually emerged as one the leading educational institutions of Rajasthan. The Mewat area has long been known for its communal amity and cultural heritage to which Babu Shobha Ram Govt. Arts College, Alwar is a valuable addition. It is hoped that in the years to come, this institution will take its rightful place one of the premier institutes of the country where the youth will receive value-enriched education along with encouragement to explore life with all its possibilities.

Every year the college enrol more than 5000 students in its 08 PG Departments and 02 UG Departments. The college also provide research facilities in 10 different subjects of humanities & social sciences.

The Department of Public Administration was established in the year 2009 with undergraduate curriculum and 20 students enrolled in that year. Currently 200 students take admission in this department at the undergraduate level. Besides the department also conducts other academic activities like organising webinars, e-classes etc. It also works as a research center for six Research Scholars registered with R.R.B.M. University.
