The Government College Rajgarh was established in July 1967. Due to the absence of any separate building of the college, STC located on Thalia Road. Its operation was started in the school building. S.T.C. by the State Government in July 1969. The school was abolished and the building was allotted to the college. In July 1967, the three-year undergraduate course (T.D.C.) began in the first year of arts. In which compulsory subjects - compulsory English, compulsory Hindi, history of Indian culture and civilization and optional subjects. Hindi literature, political science, economics, geography, history, sociology and study of Sanskrit subjects started. TDC Science started in July 1971. Under this, apart from compulsory subject, arrangements were made to study physics, chemistry, mathematics, botany, zoology in optional subjects. Classes of commerce (TDC) started from July 1976. The study of English literature at the undergraduate level was started from the session 1984-85. Post graduate classes in History and Political Science subject in the college in July. From 1994 and M.Sc Chemistry was started from July 2010

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU" has been agreed, made and executed on this 12th day of Sept 2022

Between,

GOVT. PG COLLEGE, RAJGARH, DISTT. ALWA RAJASTHAN (herein after referred to as "GPGCR", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning there of mean and include its administrators and permitted assigns) is a state-run GOVT College, established in 1967

and

HEARTFULNESS EDUCATION TRUST(herein after referred to as "HET", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning there of mean and include its successors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) is a registered trust having its registered office at no. 40-15-9/12, Nandamuri Road, Venkateswarapuram Post Office, Vijayawada – 520 010, Andhra Pradesh, India).

(HET and GPGCR shall herein after be collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually referred to as "Party" in this MOU)

WHEREAS:

- i) **GOVT. PG COLLEGE, RAJGARH, DISTT. ALWAR, Rajasthan** is offering UG and PG programs in various streams. The college is committed to providing an educational environment for students where along with curricular aspects, extra-curricular activities are also given equal importance for the overall development of the students.
- ii) **HET** is a public charitable trust registered under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 *inter alia* with an objective to impart Heartfulness approach to various wellness programs including relaxation, meditation, value based educational programs for schools, colleges, government organizations, corporate etc. These programs are made available to all who are willingly interested in individual development and wellbeing. HET is also engaged in conducting various Teachers' training programs in collaboration with certain State Governments/ Education Institutions.
- iii) **HET** through its Heartfulness initiatives offers a way for balanced living through various meditation techniques. These simple and effective techniques gradually imbibe feelings of discipline, empathy and brotherhood which leads to mental, spiritual, and psychological well-being. They help an individual in internal transformation and external interactions.
- iv) **GPGCR** intends to obtain training and experiential learning services provided by HET on the terms agreed to herein, in order to enhance educational, social, spiritual & emotional development of students. Further, HET and GMGC in support of their interest in the field of education are desirous of promoting mutual cooperation by organizing and conducting educational workshops for mental,



spiritual and psychological well-being of the students. The Parties desire to extend the basis for friendly and cooperative collaboration by way of this MOU.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER:

1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. **GOVT. PG COLLEGE, RAJGARH, DISTT. ALWAR, Rajasthan** has represented that it is a leading institute that offers high quality education and its priority is to provide its students values, inner development that enables them to perform better in their education and be leaders in nation building. GMGC seeks to provide its students with the basic life skills to manage challenges in their relationships, avoid intoxicating abuses, digital dependence and deal with the stress of modern life.
- 1.2. HET has agreed to be helpful in such mission through its programs specifically developed for specific needs without any financial burden on GPGCR.
 - A **Staff Training:** HET shall impart a training program on "Wellness at work" to the Principal, Teachers and Staff of the GPGCR institution at its campus. GPGCR may at its sole discretion make it compulsory for their faculty/staff. Initially, this would be a three-day program to introduce the Heartfulness Meditation Practice and how it can be integrated into best education practices.
 - B **HELM (Heartfulness Enabled Leadership Mastery) curriculum for students:** HET shall begin an in-depth training for students. This would cover a [3 day] induction program and a [16-week] life-skills course which will be followed by subsequent foundational leadership programs such as 'Discover', 'Develop', 'Deepen', 'Dedicate' etc. which can be included as credit courses. These are core Heartfulness programs conducted by certified Heartfulness trainers which will be experiential sessions of 60-90 minutes for each student group.
 - C **Internships for students:** Faculty offering 'Heartful Electives' can design projects that aim to integrate ethical and contemplative aspects into particular student projects.
 - D **Leadership Conclave/Roundtable on Heartfulness Leaderships:** HET shall conduct a 3-day workshop for the Principal and faculty members of GPGCR in which light will be thrown on the relationship between meditation & education.
- 1.3. Both the Parties, hereby express their commitment to collaborate with each other to conduct (i) educational, (ii) Heartfulness relaxation, meditation and (iii) other connected wellness workshops to help students, teachers to regulate their minds, moderate their tendencies, increase their concentration, sharpen the use of their will and to develop habit of tolerance, introspection and self-analysis. Through such workshops and Offerings of HET, they intend to help the students to improve their learning skills and behaviour, and inculcate humility, emotional maturity, confidence, stress management, self-awareness and most importantly, develop a sense of purpose towards life.

2. FACILITATORS

Both the Parties shall nominate one or more representatives, who shall be the point of contact/ facilitator ("Facilitators") for the purposes of this MOU. The Facilitators of



the respective Parties shall maintain regular contact with each other. Further, they shall propose and review the response received from the participants for the workshops and other activities that may be conducted pursuant to this MOU and in furtherance to fulfilling the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU.

3. RESOURCES

- 3.1. GPGCR shall make arrangements at its agreed venue(s) with required reference and reading material as specified by HET (though the reading material including photocopies, etc. would have to be provided by HET) It shall establish a (i) Heartfulness corner in the library, and (ii) meditation practice room, and (iii) providing such audio-visual equipment and other facilities as shall be required for conducting the workshops and/or programs with respect to the Offerings. Provided that all such arrangements shall be made out of the existing resources available with the GMGC and no expenses shall be borne by GPGCR.
- 3.2. HET shall nominate such teachers, trainers and support staff as it deems necessary for conducting and providing training to participants at these workshops and programs pursuant to this MOU.
- 3.3. HET shall provide support to orient GPGCR teachers, who are voluntarily ready to do so, to conduct the sessions as advised by HET for the students. Through these Offerings HET will make students at GPGCR understand values and their role in improving the quality of their life. As an extended activity it will enable them to impart spiritual training in their institutions as and when feasible.
- 3.4. HET agrees to distribute reading materials/ literature to the participants, through any means including audio and/or video recordings, books and magazines as deemed fit. HET shall share the contents of such reading materials, literature, video recordings and other such material with GPGCR, before distributing the same to the participants.

4. OTHER OBLIGATIONS OF GPGCR

- 4.1. GPGCR will help HET in promoting the offerings so that the greater populace of students in GPGCR shall get benefit.
- 4.2. GPGCR shall
 - i) Take initiatives such that its faculty and students shall attend the sessions conducted by HET with an objective to help them develop ideal value systems within;
 - ii) Facilitate students to integrate and imbibe such values into their lives and education;
 - iii) Conduct survey to find the effectiveness of the programs.
 - iv) Encourage its students, faculty, staff and administration to share written, audio and/or video testimonials with respect to any training programs, workshops or seminars conducted by HET.

5. FACILITIES UNDERSTANDING

- 5.1. HET shall provide its services with respect to Heartfulness meditation practices on free of charge basis at all times as agreed. However, it is hereby agreed that certain facilities relating to limited training programs, workshops and faculty shall be provided in the following manner. GPGCR shall provide following facilities:
 - i) Rooms for heartfulness corner, meditation, Library and other such facilities already available in GPGCR. GPGCR shall not bear any financial burden.



- ii) **No expense** would be undertaken by GPGCR for training programs for faculty and students organized at HET centres,

5.2. Logistics and Hospitality:

- (i) GPGCR shall not bear any kind of travel expenses for any of the HET trainers and special guests who are invited to GPGCR for conducting sessions/programs.
- (ii) GPGCR may provide hospitality and tangible support to the trainers and special guest only with the available resources, without bearing any financial burden.

6. TERM

- 6.1. This MOU has been executed for the purpose of organizing workshops/ seminars/ training sessions at the premises of GPGCR.
- 6.2. This MOU shall come into effect from the execution Date and shall remain in force for a period of one year thereafter.
- 6.3. This MOU shall terminate after completion of the term of one year from the Execution Date, without any financial obligations to Parties.
- 6.4. The Parties may execute similar agreements for similar initiatives in future or even extend the term of this MOU for such further periods as prior mutually agreed to by the Parties.
- 6.5. Either Party may voluntarily terminate this MOU by giving a 1 month notice in writing to the other.

7. ASSIGNMENT

This MOU is personal to the Parties and the rights and obligations established herein shall not be assignable by the Parties, except to the extent expressly permitted under this MOU.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Neither Party shall exercise any rights in the trademarks, copyright or other intellectual property of the other Party. The provisions of prevailing law relating to trademark and copy right shall be followed strictly.

9. INDEMNITY

The services provided by HET's with respect to the Offerings are on a mutual basis and free of cost. Only the willing participants who are concerned for their own wellbeing / self-development are required to participate. For development of its students GPGCR may make the HET programs, modules and/or workshops as part of its curriculum. The Parties, therefore, agree that such services do not give rise to any kind of damage or liability to anybody who participates and therefore no damage can arise there from. No indemnity is therefore provided herein. The Parties agree that HET programs do not guarantee success of its objectives or purposes as mentioned anywhere in this MOU.

10. GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION & ARBITRATION




- 10.1. This MOU shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with laws of India. Offerings made by HET are free of cost, therefore, there is no financial involvement. Even then in case of any differences between the Parties, they shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation within 10 days. If dispute does not resolve it shall be referred to a sole arbitrator appointed by both the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- 10.2. The courts of competent jurisdiction in Udaipur, Rajasthan shall have exclusive jurisdiction with respect to any and all matters pertaining to this MOU.

11. MISCELLANEOUS

- I. This MOU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of both the Parties. No modification or amendment to this MOU and no waiver of any of the terms or conditions hereof shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and duly executed by or on behalf of both the Parties.
- II. The arrangement contemplated herein being in the nature of cooperative strategic alliance for general wellbeing, no monetary consideration is involved.
- vii) None of the provisions of this MOU as stated above shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between HET and GPGCR and neither Party shall have any authority to bind or shall be deemed to be the agent of the other in any way.
- viii) GPGCR agrees that the participants to any of the HET program shall participate voluntarily. The practices prescribed by HET are not substitutes for any medical prescription or medical advice, if any, recommended by any medical practitioner.






