<p>In response to question; What had been your disappointments during your course of study?</p> <p>7% of the respondents mentioned shortage of staff, 4 % mentioned lack of autonomy to the college regarding syllabus preparation, exam, practical etc, 4% mentioned lack of computer lab and 4% mentioned lack of sports facilities as major disappointment during their course of study.</p>	<p>Appointment of faculty and staff is under the power of state government.
