Policy of Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC)

The Equal Opportunity Cell was formed in Janki Devi Bajaj Government Girls College Kota in August 2022 as per the mandate of UGC. The main objective of the EOC is to facilitate affirmative action to ensure equal opportunities for all within its fold. The EOC works for the benefit of the students belonging to the less privileged groups i.e. SCs, STs, OBCs (non-creamy layer), minorities, and differently-abled Students.

The College offers the following facilities for the benefit of its students:

- Scholarships and Financial Support
 - The College provides Scholarships and Financial Support to a number of students under various categories. The financial support is provided by the state and central governments and other bodies. The main responsibility of the Equal Opportunity Cell is to ensure that the students from the less privileged groups of SCs/ STs/ OBC/ and minorities are benefited through these schemes.
 - The EOC and the Scholarship Committees disseminate information related to the schemes and programs for the students.
 - The Differently-abled Students, SC/ST, and EWS category students are being given tuition fee waivers.
- Preserve the rights of Minorities
 - The College's strength comprises of students from all communities - Muslims, Sikhs, and Jains. The College ensures that there is no discrimination on grounds of minority status.
 - It is ensured that the rights of ethnic, religious, and linguistic minorities are considered. Protection of their identity is ensured. They benefit from the

principles of effective participation and non-discrimination in all College activities.

- Providing Infrastructural facilities to Differently-abled/ Divyangjan
 - The College building is disable-friendly to ensure hassle-free stay and movement of such students. There are ramps for students with mobility impairment for easy accessibility.
 - The College has special toilets for differently-abled students.
 - The authorities and students are very supportive, considerate, and empathetic to the students with special needs. Special care is taken while allotting timetables to students. They are encouraged to participate in various activities.
- Grievance Redressal
 - Complaints of students and staff members (teaching and non-teaching) if any, are addressed on regular basis.
- Gender Sensitization
 - Various committees of the college, NSS, NCC, Women Cell, etc. ensure the participation of students in various activities conducted for raising awareness about gender equality.
- Equal opportunities for SCs and STs
 - The College follows the Admission Policy and the guidelines of the Commissioner, of College Education regarding the reservation of seats for the disadvantaged sections for admission to different courses.

 - The College celebrates its cultural heritage and festivals on all occasions.


➤ Students from various economic and religious backgrounds seek admission to the College.
