- **Rovering/Rangering is an international voluntary non-political educational movement for youths.**
- **Senior wing of Scouting and Guiding.**
- **Started by founder of the scouting movement Lord Powell in 1919.**
- **Any regular student of College/ University between the age group of 16-25 years can be enlisted as Rover (Boy)/ Ranger (Girl).**
- **A unit consists of 24 Rovers called Rover crew and 24 Rangers called ranger team.**

Objectives -

- **A Rover and a Ranger lead themselves towards the development of their own character while supporting their families and society.**
- **Students in college are motivated to make positive contributions to their families, schools, and institutions, providing assistance to society without any self-interest.**
- **It provides an ideal platform for students of every age group to engage in social welfare service alongside their studies through various camps. Multi-dimensional skills are also developed in the students, which motivate them to work confidently in all situations.**

Qualification, Certificate and Badges -

- **After three months of joining Crew/Team. He/she shall be known as Pravesh Rover/ Ranger.**
- **A “Pravesh Rover/Ranger” is eligible to become a “Nipun Badge Rover/Ranger”**
- **A Nipun Rover/Ranger is eligible to become a Rajya Puraskar Badge Rover/Ranger.**
- **After one year a Rajya Puraskar Rover/Ranger is eligible for Rashtripati Puraskar, which is one of the heights achievement of a Rover/Ranger in his career.**
