# B. B. D. Government College, Chimanpura (Shahpura) Jaipur Annual Report 2022-23

A brief account of various activities in different spheres and their accomplishments during the academic year 2022 - 2023.

Courses offered: The College offers the following nine (3 UG + 6PG) programmes:

- UG (3years)- B.Sc. and B.Com. with 910 students.
- UG (4years)- B.Sc. Honours in Agriculture with 214 students.
- PG (2 years) -M. Com. in ABST, EAFM and Bus. Adm.; M.Sc. in Botany, Chemistry(SFS) and Zoology (SFS). The total strength in PG is 185.

- 50 Research papers were published

### **Academic Accomplishments of Students:**

- 47 students of B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture did their project work under READY Programme.
