Feedback Analysis 2021- 22 of Feedback Forms

For the due adjective of the educational environment, physical resources and basic facilities of the college feedbacks were obtained from students, parents and teachers.

According to 422 respondents received, about 80% girl students are fully satisfied with teaching, completion of curriculum, teacher- student interaction, teaching style and effectiveness, assignments, practical training, learning opportunities and online classes. About 85% of the girl students are fully satisfied with the efforts of the college for library, laboratory, use of information and communication technology, sports and other activities, life skills and employment skills. Besides suggestions regarding starting post- graduation classes in other subjects, for more use of information and communication technology, availability of more books in the library, efforts for higher placements, NCC, canteen, transport facility etc. were also suggested from the students.

According to 385 feedbacks received from the parents, 73% parents got their daughters admitted in this college for overall development and 14.8% aimed to prepare them for employment and 10.3% aimed to get only degree. Wherein 1.6%, of the parents got their daughters admitted in the college only for scholarships and Sooty. About 92% parents are completely satisfied with the academic environment and online classes of the college. About 85% parents are satisfied with co- scholastic, sports and social activities and 88% with the condition of basic facilities and security of the girl students. 91% parents rated the teacher- parent relationship as good. Suggestion from the parents included starting classes in English Literature, Sociology, Public Administration at UG level and Geography, Home-Science, Biology, Physics, Mathematics, Psychology, Economics etc. at post graduate level as well as development of laboratories and library. They also suggested the development of employment- oriented education by incorporating modern education, Indian culture and more use of projector aids, employment- oriented vocational courses through joint efforts of parents, students and teachers.

According to 28 feedbacks received from the teachers of the college, about 80% teachers agree with the level, size, flexibility and employability of the present curriculum, about 60% with the availability of books in the library and 96% e- teaching facilities. 92% teachers accept healthy and balanced environment among teachers and administrators. About 85% teachers consider the environment to be completely favourable for research work, seminars and use of new methods and techniques in teaching work. 95% of the teachers agree with the availability of opportunities for research and academic growth and 60.8% teachers have accepted the evaluation process and examination system of the students as correct. They emphasised on the expansion of library and reading room, building expansion, development of modern educational resources by the teachers, along with the participation of government colleges in the curriculum planning process of the university and the adoption of internal assessment in the evaluation process of the students.

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
