

Government Girls College, Chomu (Jaipur)

Report on Feedback Analysis 2022-23

The college received feedback from students, parents, teachers, respected citizens of Chomu Tehsil, and alumni to analyse the educational environment of the college, physical resources, basic facilities, and the efforts by the college to develop the students' personalities and bring them into the mainstream.

Based on 409 feedbacks received from students, it has been revealed that 86% of the students are highly satisfied with the teaching and curriculum. The satisfaction rate covers various aspects such as teacher-student communication, teaching style, effectiveness, internal assessment, training, internship, field visits, learning opportunities, and subject combinations available. Approximately 87.8% of students expressed satisfaction with the library, laboratory, educational activities (including the use of information and communication technology), sports, life skills, college's efforts toward employment skills, cleanliness, drinking water facility, and student safety. The students have given suggestions for introducing postgraduate courses in Home Science, Geography, Mathematics and Physics. They have also suggested more extensive usage of information and communication technology, availability of more books in the library, and arrangements for a reading room, NCC, canteen, hostel, college uniform, and transportation facility.

Based on the 279 feedbacks received from the parent group, it has been noted that 55.2% of the parents have a higher level of education, while 30.5% have completed their secondary level of education, 12.5% have completed primary education, and 1.8% are illiterate. Out of these parents, 70.3% have admitted their wards to college for overall development; 19.7%

prioritise employment for their wards; 7.5% of parents have admitted their wards to obtain degrees and 2.5% aim for scooty and scholarships. About 90.30% of the parents consider the educational environment and teacher-parent relations of the college as good and 90% of the parents are satisfied with the status of co-scholastic sports and social utility activities, basic facilities and student safety. The parent group mentioned the necessity of having additional teachers in the college and recommended introducing various subjects at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The suggested subjects for the undergraduate level are English Literature, Philosophy, Sociology, Public Administration, and Statistics, while for the postgraduate level, the subjects are Home Science, Mathematics, Psychology, Geography, Physics, and Economics. Moreover, they also suggested providing transportation facilities, college uniforms, and establishing the National Cadet Corps (NCC) unit.

Based on feedback received from 30 faculty members, including 15 Professors, nine Associate Professors and six Assistant Professors, it was found that 94% of teachers believe that the current curriculum is appropriate in terms of flexibility and employability. Additionally, 80% of teachers agree that the library has sufficient books available. A majority of 96.7% of teachers accept a healthy and harmonious atmosphere between 'Administration-teachers'. Moreover, 90% of teachers believe that the availability of new teaching methods, techniques, seminars, group discussions, and the use of information communication technology in teaching are favourable opportunities. 76.7% of teachers agree that there are enough opportunities for research work and academic growth, while 90% of teachers find the evaluation process and examination system to be suitable. Furthermore, teachers have suggested expanding the library and reading room, increasing the building's size, using modern resources, and involving the students more. Additionally, suggestions have been

made to ensure the smooth and successful implementation of the new education policy and to introduce a biometric attendance system for students.

According to the 75 feedback forms received from the esteemed citizens of Chomu Tehsil, 95% of citizens have considered that the academic environment, co-curricular activities and socially useful activities of the college contribute to the all-round development of girl students. 87% of citizens acknowledge the excellence of the college's efforts for maintaining the basic facilities, cleanliness, environmental protection and awareness in the college. From the point of view of students' welfare and safety, 97.33% of the citizens deem the environment of the college as safe and these citizens are determined to support the upliftment of the college and have also contributed to the college's progress as Bhamashah, by participating in tree plantation drives and supporting the college from time to time.

We have received feedback from 44 alumni of the college. According to the feedback, 72.7% of the students are pursuing further studies, 25% of the female students are employed, and 2.3% are homemakers. Out of the working women, 13.6% work in the government sector; 20.5% work in the private sector; 11.4% own businesses, and 54.5% are engaged in other work. Additionally, 97.7% of the alumni wish to recommend this college to their friends and family. According to reports, the college has improved the size of its undergraduate and postgraduate courses, as well as the ability to develop professional skills. 95% of former students have praised the educational environment of the college, highlighting the effectiveness of new teaching methods and techniques. Additionally, the college has received recognition for its efforts in helping students to integrate into society by enhancing their overall personality through internal assessments and personality development programmes. 92% of students have acknowledged that sports and games activities have proven to be socially useful. Additionally, 95% of students have agreed that they have access to ample

opportunities to participate in co-scholastic activities. Furthermore, 95% of students have accepted that the knowledge they have acquired has been useful in both their workplace and home area. Former students have also shared their achievements.

- A student of M.Sc. Chemistry of the college bagged the gold medal by securing the first position in the Rajasthan University.
- While holding the post of Student Union President and Vice President, students got the opportunity for personality development.
- After post-graduation from college, students have passed the NET & JRF examinations.
- Many students are pursuing a B.Ed. after successfully clearing the PTET exam.
