An Introduction

The Rajasthan School Of Art is the oldest institution of Rajasthan, promoting Art and Culture in the State. It owes its inception and growth to a great lover and patron of Art, Maharaja Sawai Ram Singh II, A ruler of the erstwhile princely state of Jaipur. The School was started in 1857 A.D., Initially with the name "Madarsa-E-Hunari", i.e. The institute of Art. In course of time, the institute became a pioneer in the field of art with as many as forty different disciplines of art and craft on its curriculum. Eventually it came to be known as "Maharaja School of Arts and Crafts" in 1886 A.D. The present Institution, "Rajasthan School of Art" is the successor of the above mentioned institute which has now acquired a renowned place in the teaching and learning of Visual Arts.

The institution was running under the administrative control of Directorate, College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur. Presently the institution has been upgraded as a Postgraduate College vide Govt. of Raj. order no.i1(23) f"k{kk@xzqi-3/2013 dated 25-09-2013. The Institution has a glorious past and impeccable academic reputation. Graduates from this college are leaders in the field of contemporary art. BVA (Four Year) Course Admission Procedure, Rules & Regulations

Admission procedure:

- 1. For admission to this course, the candidate should apply only on the prescribed form. This form will be download from college website (https://hte.rajasthan.gov.in/college /gcrsajaipur).
- Duly filled application forms should be submitted to the office by hand or by Post on working week days between 10:00 AM. to 2:00 P.M. The applicant must deposit 20/- as registration fees in cash while depositing the admission form. If you are submitting application form by post then enclosed **postal order** of 50/- in favour of **Principal, Rajasthan School of art, Jaipur** Which will be payable at Jaipur
- 3. The applicant must furnish attested copies of the following documents along with the admission form.
 - a. Mark sheet of Senior Secondary Examination.
 - b. Certificate/Mark sheet of Secondary Examination.
 - c. Transfer certificate from the institution last attended.
 - d. Character certificate from the institution last attended.
 - e. SC/ST/OBC/MBC/Reservation on Economic Basis/ PH Certificate (Whichever is necessary).
 - f. Migration certificate (original) and xerox copy of Aadhar Card

- 4. Forms incomplete in any respect will not be accepted.
- 5. Names of the students admitted to a Course will be displayed on the Notice Board and college website on the specified date. No individual communication will be made to the candidate in this regard.
- 6. Students should deposit the fees on the specified date. Admission of the student, who fails to deposit the fees by the specified date, shall stand cancelled and the candidate lower on the merit list will be next preferred. No extension will be granted for depositing the fee. Student getting admission should obtain their identity Card from the College Office. They should always keep it in their possession and produce it whenever asked for.
- 7. The following categories of students will not be eligible for admission.
- a. Candidates who are declared unsuccessful in the qualifying examination.
- b. Candidates who are detained from appearing in the examination on account of shortage of attendance.
- c. Candidates who did not appear in the examination despite meeting the minimum attendance requirement.

- 8. Following cases of students shall not be given admission in any case:
 - a. Any candidate against whom F.I.R. has been lodged by the Principal or any other authority.
 - b. Any candidate who has been convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude.
 - c. Any candidate who has indulged himself/ herself in misbehavior with any teacher or with any authority/official/ students of the college.
- 9. After the last date of submission of application no form will be accepted.

Declaration in the following form shall be made by each student at the time of admission.

I declare that:

- 1. I have not been convicted of any criminal offence nor have T been incarcerated/ released on bail in connection with a criminal case.
- 2. No case of criminal offence or moral turpitude is pending against me in any court of Law.
- 3. No complaint or F.I.R. has been lodged against me by the Principal or any other competent Authority.
- 4 I have not resorted on any act of indiscipline during the previous year, and
- 5. I know that I am required to have minimum 75% attendance in each subject (theory & practical) to appearfor the Examination.

Renewal of Admission

- 1. All the students taking / passing the qualifying examinations will be provisionally admitted to the next higher class / subject within three days of reopening of the institution after summer vacations. Teaching will commence soon thereafter and attendance will be counted from the date the teaching commences.
- 2. Formal admission form will have to be submitted and fees deposited by the notified date, failing which the provisional admission will stand cancelled.

General Rules:

- 1. Wherever these rules are not clear or silent Admission Policy 2023-24 of the Directorate College Education/Rules of the University of Rajasthan will be the guiding principles.
- 2. Incomplete admission forms will not be accepted/will be rejected without prior information to the candidate.
- 3. The principal has powers to refuse cancel admission without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 4. Students indulging in criminal acts/ grave misconduct misbehavior with teachers or employees of the institution or with other students will be deal with strictly.
- 5. Students are expected to keep their material under lock and key. The institution will not be responsible for any loss by any means and under any circumstances.

- 6. Students are required to bring their own material for work in class.
- 7. All information / orders for the students will be displayed on the notice board on time. All students will be bound by such information/ orders.
- 8. Over-stay in the class room will not be permitted without the prior written recommendation or presence of the concerned teacher, who himself/ herself will remain present with students.
- 9. Principal has the power to make changes in the information contained in the prospectus through notices displayed on the Notice Board.

Admission Rules.

BVA PART - I

Eligibility will be as follows:

1. Candidates who have passed Senior Secondary or Equivalent Examination from any place outside Rajasthan and are not resident of Rajasthan should have:

At least 60 percent marks in senior secondary or equivalent examination

2. Candidate who have passed the above examination from any place outside Rajasthan but are residents of Rajasthan.

Candidate who have passed the above examination from any school situated in Rajasthan.

At least 48 percent marks for BVA Part-1

Admission will be made as per merit of the Senior Secondary Examination. Preference for specialization subject (viz., Painting, Applied Art and Sculpture) given by the candidate in the application forms shall be strictly followed. After admission, no change of subject will be allowed.

After passing the eligibility examination admission may still not be allowed to the male candidate if there is a gap of more than two academic sessions (this condition does not apply to women candidates).

Merit lists of all the eligible candidates will be prepared subject wise for B.V.A. Pt-1 will be displayed on the notice board and website. Candidates are expected to look these lists upon the Notice Board regularly.

Candidates on the merit lists will be called for verification of documents on a notified date and time, where eligible candidates will be required to produce and deposit all the original documents Thereafter, the candidates will be given admission as per his/her choice of department, subject to availability of seats in the department.

Please note that candidates on the list

OR

will be required to deposit the fees. Candidates, not depositing the original documents and the fees, will forfeit his / her chance of admission.

RESERVATION

1. Reservation of seats / relaxation of marks for S.C., S.T., O.B.C., M.B.C. (except the creamy layer), reservation on economic basis and the physically Handicapped.

Reservation of seats is available as per admission policy / rules 2023-24. (Part 6-point No. 6.1 to 6.12) issued by the Director, College Education, Rajasthan. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, O.B.C. and M.B.C. in the ratio of 16%, 12%, 21% 5% and 10%. (Eligible, however, will be minimum 48% marks in +2).

- A. 5% of the total number of seats in each course will be reserved for physically handicapped candidates in respective categories, provided that the candidate is capable of doing practical work.
- B. Candidates claiming concession under clause IA as above shall be required to furnish a certificate in original form from the Rehabilitation center /CM & HO or equivalent/ authorized Medical Officer.

ENROLMENT, ATTENDANCE AND EXAMINATIONS

Enrolment & Eligibility:

No one shall be admitted to any examination of the university unless enrolled as a student of the university. The enrolment fee shall be paid once only, irrespective of the number of times the candidate appears for the examination of the University or whether he/she appears as a regular student or an ex-student.

ATTENDANCE:

Attendance rules as prescribed by the university and the government will be applicable to all the students Each student should attend not less than 75% of lectures delivered and the practicals held in each subject/paper during each year of the course of study. Shortage of attendance in any theory or practical subject shall disqualify the student from taking the examination. It will be the duty of the student to find out/keep abreast of their class attendance every month from teacher concerned.

EXAMINATIONS

Examinations are conduct according to the syllabus prescribed for the different courses. Students areadvised to purchase a copy of the syllabus of their courses and to acquaint themselves with the rules and regulations.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

GENERAL

The following provisions are laid down for dealing with the cases of indiscipline.:

- If a student is found accused, guilty of serious criminal charge (s), grave misconduct, persistent negligence of work or misbehavior, the Principal will forthwith exert to initiate suspension proceedings against him/ her during the period of suspension, the student will not be allowed to participate in any activity of the institution including appearance in the examination.
- 2. Soon after suspension, the case will be referred to the discipline committee constituted for this purpose. The discipline committee will meet and after due consideration, recommend suitable punishment which may include fine or expulsion for a fixed period/permanent or both.

The Punishment will be implemented by the authority which has suspended the student.

3. If a criminal case has been registered in a court of Law by the police (state)

the student shall be suspended immediately pending enquiry.

- 4. No student who has been suspended/ expelled or rusticated shall be admitted to any other college/ teaching unit without permission of the authority who has suspended/ expelled/rusticated him/her.
- 5. All cases of indiscipline shall be reported to the parents/guardians of the concerned student.
- 6. If any student damages the college property, the student or his parents shall be required to compensate the damage incurred in addition to the disciplinary action initiated against him/her.
- 7. Ragging of any kind in any form is prohibited in the campus and shall attract the sternest provisions in consonance accordance with recent Supreme Court Rulings.

RULES FOR EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES

(For BVA only)

- 1. No tuition fee will be charged from SC ST, OBC, MBC & PH candidates?
- 2. Women candidates and wards of exarmy men are also exempted from payment of tuition fees.

SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

There are several schemes of financial assistance available to different categories of students. These are available through different agencies. Merit-cumneed scholarship, National Scholarship, Fine Art Scholarship, National Loan Scholarship are available through the Director, College Education, Rajasthan. The financial assistance to SC/ST students is available through the Department of Social Welfare. The freeships and half free. ships are also given to the needy and deserving students from the student aid fund.

CHIEF MINISTER HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

All students of BVA Part I are hereby notified that those desirous of availing the Chief Ministers Higher Education Scholarship should fulfill the following requirements.

1. Applicant's parental income from all sources should not exceed 2.50 lacs per annum.

- 2. Applicant's from either of the three faculties (viz, Science Commerce, Arts) must score 60% or more aggregate marks in the Senior Secondary Examination.
- 3. Applicant should not be drawing any other scholarship from any other source/ department/ institution.
- 4. Applicant can download the application form for the scholarship from the website www.collegeeducation.gov.in before submitting it duly filled in at the concerned college/office.

If a student desires further information about various types of scholarships or financial assistance, he/ she may contact the Director College Education Govt of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

No financial assistance shall be given to any student who has been found guilty of indiscipline and suffers shortage of attendance.

STUDY TOUR

A study tour to the places of Art and Culture is compulsory for every student and is arranged every year within the available resources. Selection of the places of tour and the participants is done by a committee appointed by the Principal. A short tour may also be permitted depending upon available funds to the students of MVA and BVA Pt. IV (Outside Rajasthan) BVA Pt. III (Within Rajasthan) BVA Pt. II (Within Jaipur Division) and BVA Pt. I (Within Jaipur District) in order of preference respectively.

MVA (Four Semester) Course ADMISSION RULES

MVA Course has been running in Rajasthan School of Art, since the academic session 2003-2004 and is affiliated to the University of Rajasthan.

This postgraduate course in Visual Arts is available in three disciplines with 12 seats each in the department of Painting, Applied Art and sculpture respectively.

Duration:

Four Semesters

Eligibility:

Candidates with minimum 55% of aggregate marks in BVA/BFA alone are eligible. The admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.

A candidate can apply only for the same subject of specialization which he/she had selected in his/her BVA/BFA course.

Reservation to SC/ST/OBC/MBC/ Reservation one Economic basis candidates is available as per Government Rules i.e. 16%, 12%, 21%, 5% & 10% respectively.

All rules regarding the procedure for admission eligibility/non eligibility and

general rules related to the BVA course in Rajasthan School of Art are applicable to MVA course also. The admission policy for the year 2023-24 of the Director, College Education and the University of Rajasthan will be applicable.

Candidates passing B.V.A./B.F.A. Examination from any place outside Rajasthan and are not resident of Rajasthan should have at least 60 percent marks in Examination.
