Swargia Rajesh Pilot Government College, Bandikui is a pioneer co-educational institution in eastern Rajasthan that provides opportunities of education to the students coming from rural and economically weaker sections of the society in and around Bandikui. Swargia Rajesh Pilot Government College, Bandikui was established in 1977, as a Commerce College with only 40 students, it is affiliated to the University of Rajasthan Jaipur. Since then, it has established many milestones in its journey towards excellence in higher education. In 1983 Arts stream was included in regular government scheme by the order of Rajasthan government. Science stream was started in 2003-04 under Self-financing scheme. Post graduate programmes in Hindi and Political Science were also inducted in the Self-financing scheme, whereas M.A. Political science and Science Stream was included in regular government scheme by the order of Rajasthan government in 2013-14 and Political Science in 2016. The name of the college was changed from Government College, Bandikui to Swargia Rajesh Pilot Government College, Bandikui in 2005 by the orders of State Government. The College was initially affiliated to University of Rajasthan Jaipur and still it is.

Institutional Weakness

- Exam-centric curriculum and inability to rise to the global standards.
- Annual examination system with substantial reliance on the University allotted marks and degree.
- Few multi-disciplinary research projects with national knowledge network.
- Funding for research is not being readily provided by UGC.
- Lack of adequate freedom to move out of state for participation in research activities
- Transfers by the State Government, leading to instability in academic environment.
- Posts of non-teaching staff (librarian, DPE and others) lying vacant for a long time.
- Vacant posts of ministerial staff and supporting staff.
- Low employability due to non-availability of Professional programs.
- Low computer: student ratio.
- Limited industry participation through consultancy and projects in college.
- Inadequate documentation of post qualification employment status of students and insufficient student tracking system.

Institutional Opportunity

- Most of the students are from a rural background for which higher education is essential for a secure future and social mobility. The college is the oldest and biggest institution of the area repute, and attracts large number of students from surrounding towns and villages.
- Subsidized fee and availability of various scholarships draws students for admissions.

Strategy Implementation and Monitoring


