Railways and the aware citizens of this area have paid special attention to the development of education. Due to the active efforts of the townspeople and the visionary policy of the state government towards inclusive higher education, so that the students living in the rural and urban areas around Bandikui area do not have to go to other places for higher education. In October 1977, this college started with 40 students of the Faculty of Commerce. Subsequently, in 1983, the Faculty of Arts also started. Initially this college ran in four rooms in Dharamshala located in the center of the city.
