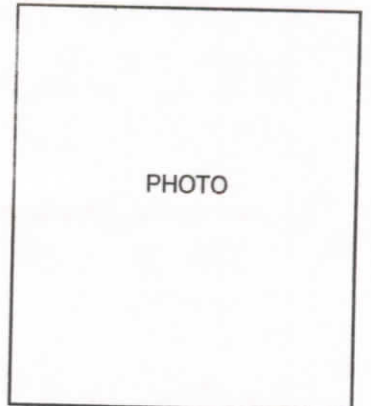

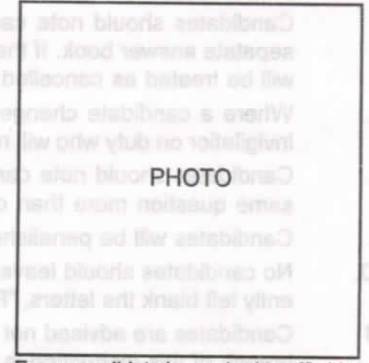

# RULES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF THE CANDIDATES

1. The examination will be held on the prescribed dates as per programme already notified. The doors will be opened on the first day half an hour before and on other days 15 minutes before the scheduled time.
2. A seat with his/her roll number will be allotted to each candidate and an answer-book to write the answer will be found on his/her desk. Candidates will be required to find and occupy the seats allotted to them.
3. No candidate without the special permission of the officer-in-charge, should leave his/her seat or the examination room till the end of examination.
4. During the course of examination, the candidate shall be under the discipline and control of the centres superintendent and shall obey all orders issued by the superintendent on all matters relating to examinations.
5. Urinals for the use of examinees shall be provided by centers and every examinee shall be required to use only those urinals only.
6. Candidates should note carefully that, questions required to be answered in separate answer-book, are answered in separate answer book. If they fail to do so, question of only one section shall be examined and those of the other section will be treated as cancelled.
7. Where a candidate changes ink while he/she is answering a paper he/she should bring this fact on the notice of the invigilator on duty who will record this fact at the appropriate place and affix the Controller of examination fascimile stamp.
8. Candidates should note carefully, that it shall be deemed an offence amounting to cheating if they write answer to the same question more than once.
9. Candidates will be penalised to the extent of one mark per question if they do not number their answer correctly.
10. No candidates should leave any blank page in between any two answer in the answer-book. If a page or two is inadvertently left blank the letters, "P.T.O." Must invariably be written on that page or pages for the guidance of the examiner.
11. Candidates are advised not to write their Roll Nos, name or make any other signs or marks inside their answer-book. Any breach of this instruction is liable to be penalised.
12. Candidates should not leave the hall without handing over their answer-book to the invigilator-in-Charge.
13. All candidates are required to bring their own pens and use blue ink only for answering their questions paper. They should not bring any text-book or notes with them in the Examinations Hall, in which they are seated.
14. Candidates are forbidden from writing answer (or anything else) on the question paper or on the blotting paper.
15. CANDIDATE SHOULD READ THE QUESTIONS PAPER AND THE INSTRUCTION CAREFULLY BEFORE THEY BEING TO WRITE THEIR ANSWERS.
16. Attempt to use unfair means to pass the examination or any violation of the preceding rules or any personal approach to the examiner concerned will be subject to severe action. The candidate will be asked to submit his/her written statement in the printed proforma to be supplied by the center superintendent in the examination hall before second answer-book is given to him/her for answering. If any examinee refuses to give his/her statement on the spot or runs away from the center, his/her case will be decided by the University in absentia on the basis of the report of the Center superintendent and no representation or protest from his/her will be entertained afterwards.
17. A candidate found guilty of use of unfair means or disorderly conduct at or in connection with the examination or violation of the preceding rules or personal approaches to the examiner concerned will be liable to severe action under the provision. The candidate will be supplied with a copy of the chargesheet immediately after the examination in the paper is over and asked to submit his/her written reply on the chargesheet and also to sign the material recovered from his/her before leaving the examination hall he and she will also be given personal hearing by the Superintendent if needed. If the candidate refuses to give his/her statement on the spot and or refuses to sign the Material recovered or leaves the center without giving his/her statement or if he/she is guilty of showing disorderly conduct a notice will be sent to him/her under registered cover calling upon him/her to show cause why action should not be taken against him/her for using unfair means and or showing misconduct. Such cases will be decided by the University in absentia on the basis of the report of the Invigilator/centre Superintendent and the reply, if any, received from the candidate and no representation or protest from him/her will be entertained afterwards.
18. No enquiries by telegram or post concerning result will be answered by the Controller of Examination, candidate must wait for the announcement of their result.
19. No guarantee is given to the candidates regarding the order of the question paper.
20. In case the original Admission card is lost, its duplicate copy may be issued on receipt of an application through proper channel along with a fee of Rs. 100/-
21. Candidates must write on both sides of the leaf in their answer-book. Any rough drafting or calculation etc. may be made and cross out. These will not be read by the examiner.
22. If Candidates leaves the examination hall before the expiry of two hours, he/she must not take away his/her question paper he/she should leave it with the superintendent and can take it from him/her at the end of the examination. Answer-books should be handed over to the invigilator-in-charge.
23. Candidates are required to answer the question paper either in English or in Hindi medium whichever permissible. They are not allowed to answer the question in any other language.
24. If a candidate(s) boy-girl(s) any paper/examination it shall be at his/her own risk, Complaints against question papers if any, should be submitted to the University through the centre Superintendent concerned within 24 hours from the date of the Examination for the paper concerned, after which no complaint will be entertained. A committee will be constituted to look into the grievances and take appropriate action.
25. If candidate is unable to appear at the examination on account of sickness or other sufficient cause bail of the examination fee will be carried over to the next following examination, provided that where candidate has appeared at a practical examination held before the written examination, only one fourth amount shall be carried over. For this purpose the application on the prescribed form (obtainable from the University office on request) duly forwarded by the officer who had originally forwarded the application for admission to the examination must be sent so as to reach the Controller of Examination not earlier than the commencement of the examination and not later, than a month after the commencement of the examination at which the candidate is unable to appear in case of sickness the application shall be supported by a medical certificate from an authorised practitioner.
26. Smoking and other intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall & Room.
27. The invigilator and the members of the flying squad are empowered to take search of the examinees during the examination.
