to state that on consideration of the observations of the Expert Committee which assessed the proposal on and the recommendations made by the Standing Committee of the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) in its 5th held on 4.10.1991 thereof, subsequent discussions held on 16.7.1992 with the concerned officials of the of Technical Education and clarifications furnished on 7.7.1992 and 30.1.1993, the All India Council for Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the State Govt. of Rajasthan for introduction of 7 (seven) Diploma in the 4 (four) existing Polytechnics and for establishment of 10 (ten) Polytechnics from the academic year with duration and intakes shown against each as given below:

The above approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- 1) The infrastructural and other facilities including equipment, faculty etc. should be provided norms.
- 2) The courses should only be started when one Head of the Dept. and two Lecturers for each course and adequate infrastructural and other facilities are in position.
- 3) The curricula of the courses wherever not available should be developed in consultation with the

The State Govt. should strictly follow the recommendations made by the Expert Committees from time to time in each case and should also adhere to the provisions and commitments given in the State's Detailed Project Report submitted to the World Bank.

20. The teaching staff should be recruited on an All India basis by open selection and as per procedure, qualifications, experience etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Govt. prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
21. The admissions should be made on merit and as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE from time to time.
22. The tuition and other fees should be within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE.
23. The State Govt. will not alter the approved intakes in these Polytechnics under any circumstances without the prior approval of the AICTE.
24. The State Govt. will neither close any of the existing approved course nor start any new course in these Polytechnics without the prior approval of the AICTE.
25. The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.
26. The accounts of the Polytechnic shall be audited as per rules of the State Govt. and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
27. The State Govt. shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.


This approval is also subject to the condition that the State Govt. of Rajasthan will abide by its commitment given in letters dated 21.1.1993 and 30.1.1993 to the effect that the State Govt. will neither introduce any new course in technical education nor establish any new institution either in the Government sector or Private sector nor introduce any course/ institution in any sector in the State without the prior approval of the AICTE.

This approval is further subject to full compliance with the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgment dated 4.2.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan, J.P. and others etc. etc. State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE and the Central Government from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the State Govt. with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take necessary action for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to the State Govt. on account of approval would be that of the State Govt.

I request you to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decisions of the AICTE and communicate the same in this regard to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) of the AICTE under intimation to this office.
