**Rajiv Gandhi Scholarship for Academic Excellence**

**English Version of Guidelines released on 15.06.2022**

**In continuation of the Order no. 336 dated 05.10.2021 and amended Order no. 479 dated 16.12.2021 of the Rajiv Gandhi Scholarship for Academic Excellence Scheme, 2021 and in pursuance to Finance Department ID 152200423 dated 25.04.2022, the following orders are issued:-**

1. All categories of students will be paid 100 % of the tuition fees. However, any scholarship/ financial grant/ fellowship from any other source will be deducted from the amount of tuition fees to be paid to the student.
2. From the date of issuance of this order:-
  - i. Student whose family income is less than 8 lakhs/annum will be paid 100 % of the other expenses (maximum upto 12 lakhs/annum) in addition to the tuition fees.
  - ii. As per the previous guidelines of the scheme, the student whose family income is less than 8 lakhs/annum will be given priority in providing scholarship. Applications of the students whose family income is 8 lakhs/annum or more may be considered as follows:
    - A. Student whose family income is from 8-25 lakhs/annum will be paid 50 % of the other expenses (maximum upto 10 lakhs/annum) in addition to the tuition fees.
    - B. Student whose family income is over 25 lakhs/annum will be paid tuition fees but no amount will be paid for other expenses.
3. Expenses other than tuition fees (including accommodation) will be considered as other charges.
4. The scholarship amount (tuition fees and other charges) which was paid according to previous guidelines will be adjusted (according to clauses mentioned in this order) from the amount which is to be paid in the next year/ semester.

5. From the date of this order, clauses 1(ii) and 2 of the order dated 05.10.2021 and clause 2 of amended order dated 16.12.2021 are hereby deleted and all subjects/disciplines will be allowed at UG, PG, Ph.D. and Post Doc. levels in the top 150 universities as annexed in the scheme document ( Subject to Clause 6). Students who have applied on or before 31.03.2022 on the online portal but were not considered eligible due to subjects and degrees, permitted in the previous guidelines (Order dated 05.10.2021 and amended order dated 16.12.2021) will be given a chance under this instruction for scholarship award along with new applicants.
6. Maximum 15 students will be given scholarships for B.E, B. Tech, M.B.B.S and B.D.S, Engg. Medical etc. For this, course wise top 25 Universities as per QS ranking will be considered. (Annexure attached)
7. In case of more applicants for the selection process in the year 2022-23 for the remaining scholarship awards, merit-based selection will be followed as per QS world ranking. In case of a tie in university ranking, course ranking will be considered and later on qualifying degree marks will be considered for merit based selection.
8. From the date of this order, annexure 1 of order dated 05.10.2021 is deleted and replaced with latest QS world ranking of the top 150 universities.
